Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. 12, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 60 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

① Beginning at the point where the Camp Creek County Road crosses the line between Sec 33 and Sec 28 T. 1 S. R. 3 E. thence easterly about 900 feet, along said Section line to a point where the Camp Creek Railway crosses said Section line.

② and ③ G. O. Arnold all of Sec 33 and J. Brauner owns that portion of Sec 28 which is concerned in this road

④ G. O. Arnold consents Turner Brauner consents also

⑤ ill Consent

(f) No charge for Right of Way if first Class Road is built.

(g) The necessity for the proposed road arises from the fact that the location of Arnold's Siding is at the terminus of the proposed road. This Siding is the nearest and most convenient market for the crops produced by the signers of this petition as well as a large number of other farmers. Access to this Siding is to be had at present only by driving thro the fields of Mr. Brauner and by fording Camp Creek at the risk of injury to men, wagons and especially horses. This risk becomes of greatest magnitude during the winter on account of the ice.
