To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. _____, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 50 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

 To trading point, And A general out-let to the road up and down

Gentlemen:

The Board of County Commissioners of Gallatin County asked me as their Clerk to inquire of you, if you could obtain for them a right of way either through the center or as nearly as possible on the north or south line of section eleven (11) in Township Two(2) North of Range Four(4) East for a county road. The people in that neighborhood are anxious to get an outlet east and west and if a road can be opened it will afford an outlet to renters on Northern Pacific lands as well as to all others interested. The present renter Mr J. Cox does not want to give the right of way, merely a neighborhood quarrel, so the Board is informed, and hence the Board is asking the right of way of you, as the attorneys for the Northern Pacific R.R. Co., The road perhaps could not be laid out exactly on the section line east and west, but would be placed as nearly on the line as possible, there seems to be a hill that is hard to get over.

Please let me hear from you as soon as convenient, so that I can inform the Commissioners of the fact, as they are very anxious to get a road opened for these people.

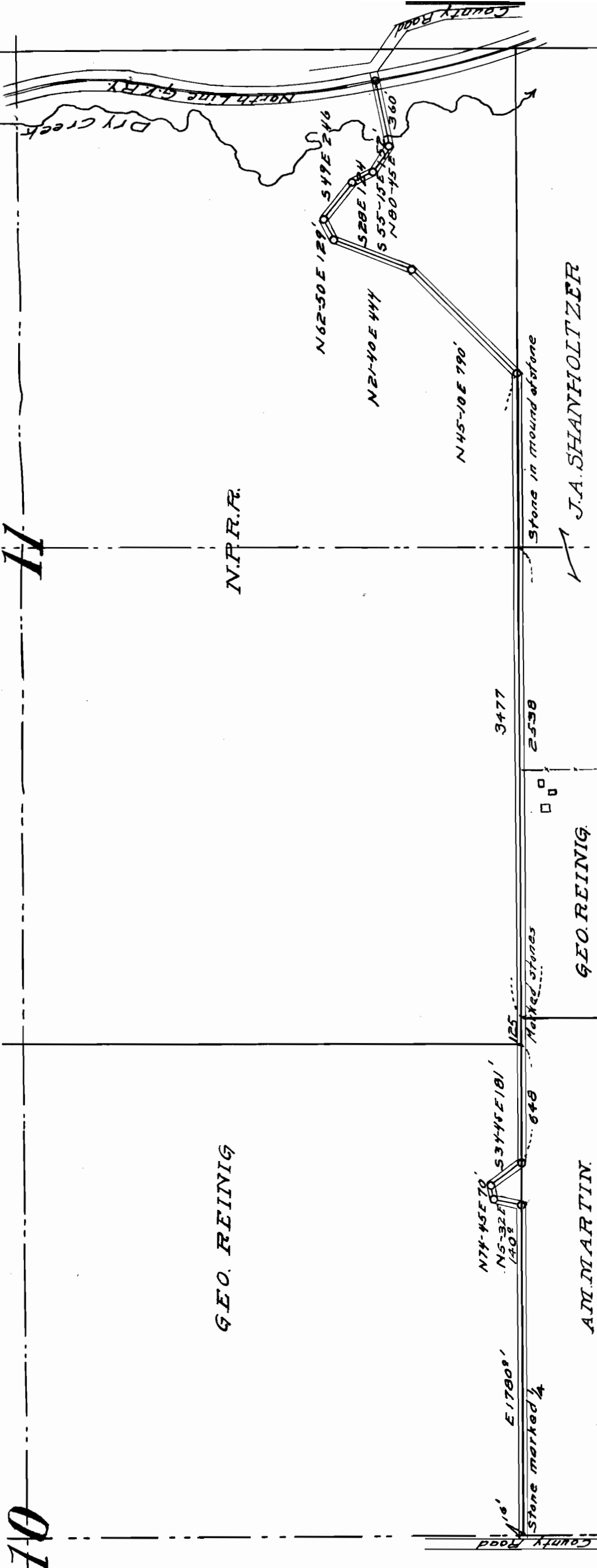
Your letter of March 12th is received
