Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road..... forty..... feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) The general route of the proposed road is as follows:.....
Beginning at the intersection of the main line of the Northern Pacific Railway and the east line of Section 4, T.1 N., R.3 E., thence north on said Section 4 and its projection a distance of about one mile to a point near the edge of the bluff, thence following said bluff to the westward to a point near the center of the North Half of Section 33, T.2 N., R. 3 E.; all of said right of way being at the present time fenced and made ready for said proposed county road.

(b) It is proposed to establish said road over the lands in Sections 33 and 34, T. 2 N., R. 3 E., and in sections 3 and 4, T. 1 N. R. 3 E.

(c) The owners of said lands are the H. S. Buell Land Company, Bozeman, Montana.

(d) The H. S. Buell Land Company consents to the opening of said road.

(e) There are no non-consenting land owners.

(f) The cost of said right of way will be nothing.

(g) The necessity for said road is as follows:

The undersigned Len Verwolf is the owner of certain lands in Sections 33 and 28, T. 2 N., R.3 E., upon which he operates a slaughter-house in connection with his butchering business in Manhattan; also the following freeholders are located on adjoining lands of said Verwolf, and have no outlet to the county road from any direction: Frank Van Ness; Ira Verwolf; Mrs. Edwin P. White; also the citizens of the town of Manhattan and vicinity secure from the river channel, to the north of said premises, their sand and gravel for building purposes and are crossing through the private fields traversed by said road, greatly to the disadvantage of all parties concerned.

Also the residents of Gallatin County residing to the north of the Gallatin River ford the river near the terminus of said proposed road and then cross the private fields and lands of the intervening land owners in reaching market at Manhattan, and the proposed route is the nearest and best route to market for these residents of Gallatin County.
