# Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. 4, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 60 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.

*John Stengrum and Char Auckey on first prepared route*

(g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

*Route No 1*  
Beginning at the North Section corner between Sections No (11) Eleven and (12) Twelve Twp 3 South Range 3 East M.P.M. and running South 100 Rods then South East about 60 Rods then South about 160 Rods to a point intersecting a Public Road in Section 13 of same Twp. & Range

*and Petitioners also ask that the following location be viewed by your Honorables Body in connection with the above proposed Route*

*Route No 2*  
Beginning at the North Section corner between Sections (12) Twelve and Section (7) Seven on Twp. line between Twp. 3 South and Range 3 East and Twp 3 South and Range 4 East and running South East about 120 Rods then South about 60 Rods to a point intersecting a Public Road in Section 7 Twp. 3 S Range 4 East John Mitchell is the owner of the land. Our Stengrum and Mr Auckey will consent to the establishing of this road through their land but do not know if Mr Mitchell will or not the Probable cost to Mr Mitchell would be \$500. the necessity of the road is that there is no Public Road that the Petitioners can haul their crops over at this time, that Petitioners have at this time to open 2 or more gates to get to Public Road

Runners to Salisbury and that the Present Route  
 of Stage is Practically impassable so far as  
 Hauling grain is concerned to Salisbury  
 Many petitioners also ask that a Survey be  
 made and that a mail practical route be  
 established of the Two named localities.
