# Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. One, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 60 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:
  - (a) Starts in the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of Section 10, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, and follows the Cotton Wood Creek west through Section 9 and 8, said township and range, and intersects with the County road on Section 17;
  - (b) Over land owned by Mrs. A. D. Potter, Boid Lehman and Fred Lehman in Sections 8, 9, and 10, Tp. 2 North, Range 3 East,
  - (c) Mrs. A. D. Potter, Boid Lehman and Fred Lehman.
  - (d) The owners of the land will donate the right of way.
  - (e) None of the owners of the land over the proposed route refuse to give right of way.
  - (f) The proposed cost of right of way will be nothing.
  - (g) If the proposed road is constructed the old road will be abandoned, the old road is not used at the present time, everone going to and fro in that part of the country travelling the route of the proposed road and if the proposed road is constructed it will reduce grades and afford easier ingress and egress to that part of the country.
  - (h) There is a road connecting the old road from Section 10, said township and range, to the Nixon Gulch road, this road is impassible and is never used. This road should be abandoned but if it is not abandoned it should be connected up with the proposed road and made passible.
