# Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road..... 40 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

a- from the Holland station south for one mile

b- east of section 20 and west side of section 21.

c- Wm. Smith. C. A. Sales. Ben A. Selle. estate of G. Johnson.

d- Wm. Smith. estate of G. Johnson.

e- C. A. Sales. Ben A. Selle.

f- C. A. Sales. right of way at the rate of \$100<sup>00</sup> per acre.  
Ben A. Selle. hog wire fence and tree barb wires.

g- Roads now using being rough and hilly where proposed road will practically be a down hill pull for hauling grain and other farm products, also for some of us petitioners a much closer road to the railroad station at Holland.
