# Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road..... 40 .....feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at the S.E. Cor. of Sec 6 T. 25. R 3 E thence westward along the South Line of said Section to the Southwest Corner of said Section following the said South Line as nearly as Brown may deem desirable thence westward along the south line of Section ~~1~~ <sup>T 25, R 2 E</sup> 1, as nearly as Brown may deem desirable to the S.W. Cor. of Sec. 7 T. 25. R 3 E. Thence northward along the West Line of said Section 1 as nearly as desirable to the N.W. Cor. of said Section 1.

(b & c) Scoulan owns Section 6. Parkins owns Sect 7. Benepe " " " " 1. Guy Jewell " " " " NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sect. 12. Watsons owns W 1/2 N.E. 1/4 and the E 1/2 N.W. 1/4 Sect 12. F. Kremer owns the W 1/2 N.W. 1/4 Sect 12. F. Kremer owns the <sup>part of</sup> Section 2. All have given written consent.

(g) There is a large acreage of wheat land adjacent and tributary to the proposed road which at present must be hauled thus the fields to market. School children are also compelled to drive thro the fields and open and close gates. There is much or less loss entailed on the owners of these fields on account of gates being left open and considerable friction has developed which has at times

threaten to lead to violence. The road would seem therefore a desirable measure to keep the peace of the community. The road is needed to complete an open route for a Rural Delivery (which would benefit about 110 families). The road will require but very little work to put it in shape for travel and its cost of maintenance will be practically nothing.
