To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners

of Gallatin County.

Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned residents and tax payers of Gallatin County, Montana, in order to have a more direct route and public highway from the city of Bozeman to Butte, Montana, and in order to connect with said proposed highway through Madison County, Montana, do most respectfully petition your Honorable Body to cause to be viewed, laid out, and opened, a public highway commencing at the Madison River where the County Road from Bozeman to Norris strikes said river at what is known as the Black crossing; thence immediately due west across said river to the west side thereof; thence north about three quarters of a mile through Section 19; township 2 South of range 2 East, leaving the same at a point near the center of the north line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 19; thence running in a northwesterly direction to Cedar Canyon, which is approximately two hundred yards north of the center of Section 13 in Township 2 South of Range 1 East; thence southwesterly up Cedar Canyon through said Section 13 to the west boundary line of Gallatin County, and to connect with a proposed highway through Madison County, which said highway through Madison County would begin at said point on said boundary line at the head of Cedar Canyon; thence run west to the center of Section 14 in Township Two South of Range One East; thence north one-half mile; thence west one-half mile to the northwest corner of said Section 14; thence North one mile along the east side of Section 10, same township and range; thence west along the north line of Sections 10, 9, 8 and 7 in said Township 2 South of Range 1 East; thence west along the south section lines of Sections 12, 11 and 10 to Norweigan Creek in Township 2 South of Range 1 West; thence angling across the southwest corner of Section 3, Township 2 South Range 1 West to the west line of said Section 3; thence north along

the west line of said Section 3 to the northwest corner thereof;
thence west along the south section lines of Sections 4, 5 and 6,
Township 2 South of Range 1 West to the town of Harrison, Montana.

We believe that the opening and maintenance of such public
highway will not alone save a distance of about twenty miles of
road as now traveled between here and said city of Butte, Montana,
but that the same will afford an outlet to the city of Bozeman for
homesteaders and others living immediately west of the Madison
River along said proposed route, and will therefore be to the
interests of Gallatin County in the way of trade and convenience,
and to this end, we most respectfully ask and request that your
Honorable Board act in conjunction with the Honorable Board of
County Commissioners of Madison County, Montana.

Chapter 72, Thirteenth Session 1913, Sections 1-2-18

CHAPTER IV

Section 1. Any ten, or a majority, of the free holders of a road district, taxable therein for road purposes, may petition in writing, the Board of County Commissioners to, establish, change or discontinue any common highway therein. When such a highway is petitioned for upon the dividing line between two counties, the same course must be pursued as in other cases, except that a copy of the petition must be presented

to the Board of County Commissioners of each County, who may appoint viewers to act jointly and the viewers so appointed must report their findings to both Boards.

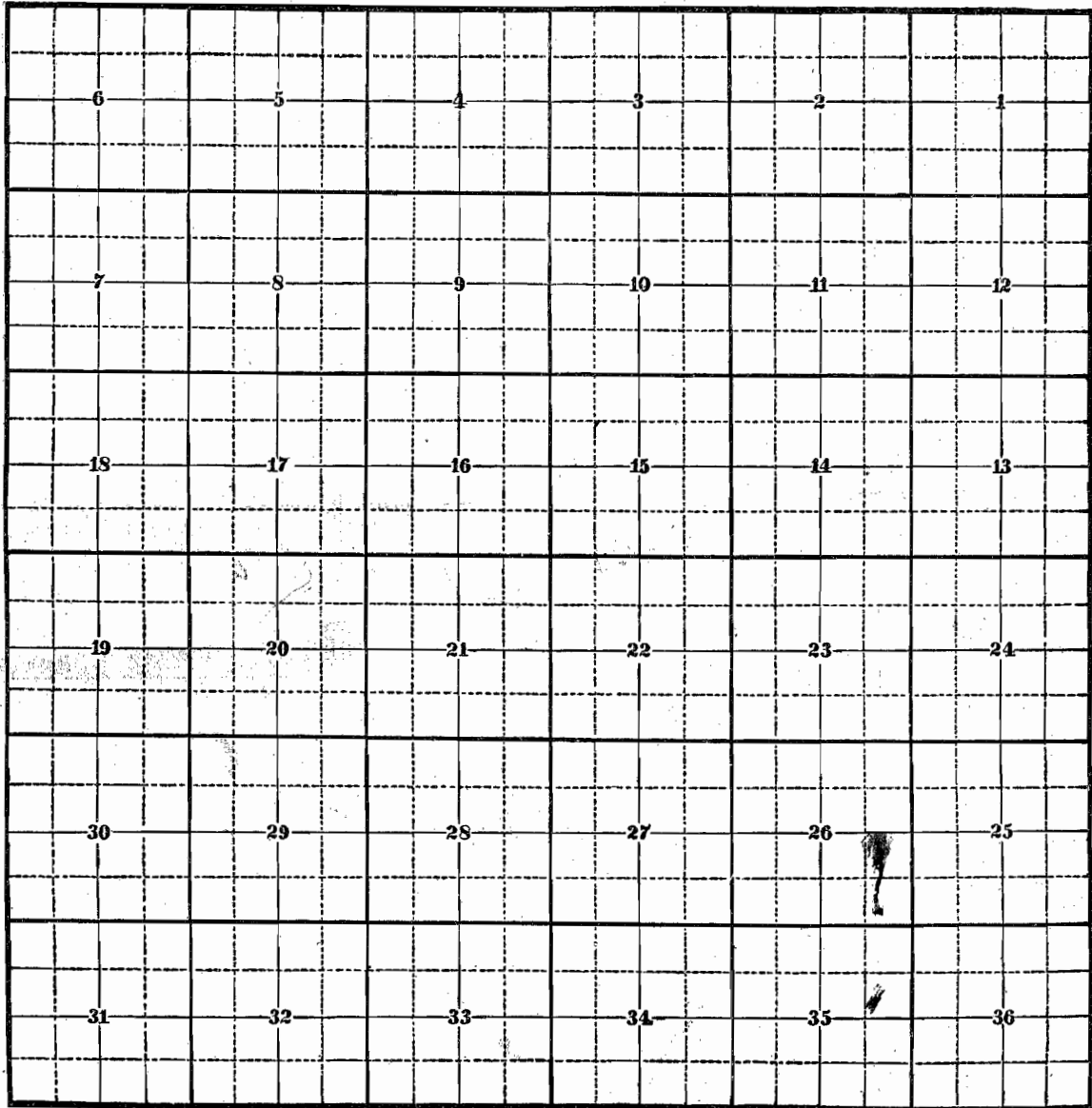
Section 2. The petition must be set forth and describe particularly the highways to be abandoned, discontinued, altered or constructed, and if the same is to be altered, laid-out or constructed, the general route thereof, over what lands, who are owners thereof, whether

such of them as can be found consent thereto, and if not the probable cost of the right-of-way, where consent is not had, the necessity for, and advantage of the proposed road.

Section 18. Highways must be laid out and opened when practicable or upon subdivision or section lines, Provided, however, that the section shall not be construed to prevent roads being laid out on diagonal lines when public purposes shall be best subserved thereby.
