PETITION FOR CHANGE IN WIDTH OF ROAD.

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1 To the Honorable, the Board of County Commissioners of
2 Gallatin County, State of Montana:

3 We, the undersigned, residents of Gallatin County,
4 State of Montana, and residing on or near the public high-
5 way hereinafter described, and being all of the persons
6 directly interested, hereby petition the Board of County
7 Commissioners of Gallatin County, State of Montana, to reduce
8 the width of a certain public highway described as follows:

9 Beginning at the Southwest corner of Sec. 33, Tp. 2 S.
10 R. 5 E., M. P. M., and running thence due East along the
11 section line to the Southeast corner of said section; thence
12 North directly along the East line of said section and the
13 East line of the section lying immediately North of said
14 section a distance of two miles; thence due West one mile
15 along the section line; thence back along said road running
16 West one mile to the point where said road turns Westerly,
17 thence continuing North along the section line a distance
18 of one mile; from a width of sixty feet to forty feet,
19 taking from each side of said road a space of ground ten
20 feet wide and permitting the owners of the adjoining lands
21 to set their fences in on such space, except however, your
22 petitioners advise that at the point where said road crosses
23 Middle Creek it would be advisable to permit said road to
24 remain at a width of sixty feet for a distance of fifty or
25 one hundred feet on each side of said Creek.

26 Your petitioners further state that all of the
27 owners of land adjoining said road have signed this petition
28 and are willing to bear and pay for all of the expenses of
29 moving or setting in the fences enclosing the land adjoin-
30 ing said road and that said change may be effected without
31 any expense whatever to Gallatin County. Your petitioners
32 further represent that said road is not a road on which the

2 general public travel extensively and consequently a width
3 of forty feet is sufficient for general public use, and that
4 there are no fills or grades which necessitate a greater
5 width than forty feet.
