TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF GALLATIN, MONTANA:-

We, the undersigned, free holders of Road District No. 7, of the County of Gallatin and taxable therein for road purposes, respectfully petition your Honorable Body to alter the public highway as now laid out and used between Sections Twenty-four (24) and Twenty-five (25) in Township 3rd () 7, 8 of Range _____ () _____, in Gallatin County, Montana, in the following manner:-

To change the middle of the said road or highway on the East line of said Sections Twenty-four and Twenty-five, from a point thirty (30) feet North of the Southeast corner of Section Twenty-four and the Northeast corner of Section Twenty-five aforesaid, to the exact corner of the said Sections, thence running in a direct line Westerly along the line between the said Sections to the Southwest corner of the said Section Twenty-four and the Northwest corner of the said Section Twenty-five.

The said road as now laid out across the said Sections lies entirely upon the said Section Twenty-four and the centre of the said road enters the said Section Twenty-four at a point thirty (30) feet North of the Southeast corner of said Section and runs thence in a direct line in a Northwesterly direction to a point ninety-five (95) North of the Southwest corner of said Section Twenty-four, instead of following the Section line between the said Sections.

Your Petitioners further represent that as the road is now constructed on either side of the said Sections, it follows the Section lines both East and West of the said highway between the said Sections, and that in going along the said highway from East to West, there is a jog or variation to the North upon approaching the said Section Twenty-four and to the South upon leaving the said Section Twenty-four.

That one N. P. Evans is the owner, and in possession of

the said Section Twenty-five hereinbefore referred to, and that your Petitioner, J. W. Bowen is the owner of said Section Twenty-four aforesaid.

That the said proposed change will necessitate the building of but one bridge, whereas as now laid out, the said road requires the maintenance of one bridge and the bridge now maintained upon the highway as laid out, is out of repair and will have to be rebuilt.

That your Petitioner, J. W. Bowen consents to the proposed change of the said highway as suggested herein.

That the Plat of the said land and the highway as now laid out across the same is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A" and made a part of this Petition.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that viewers may be appointed by your Honorable Body; that a hearing be had herein after Notice, and that such change be ordered and that the said highway be opened to the public.
