To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. 17, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

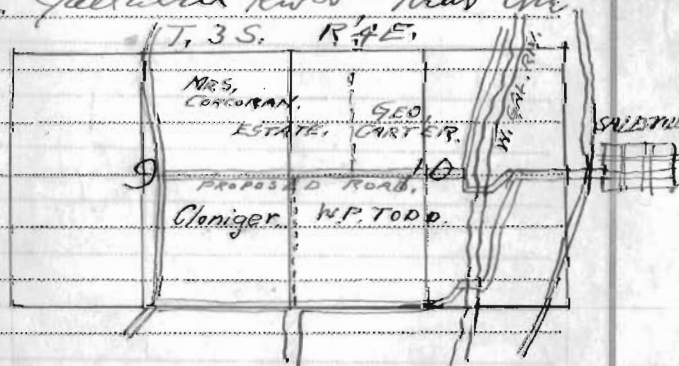
Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 40 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.

(g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at a point on the E & W 1/4 Sec. line of Sec 9 T. 3. S. R. 4 E. where the said line is intersected by the County road along the foot of the bluff on the west side of the valley, thence East along said line and the E & W 1/4 Sec. line of Sec. 10, said T. & R. to the intersection with the County road running along the west side of the West Gallatin River near the Carter bridge, see sketch.

Dear Sir:-

The Road petitioned for by Remi Monforton et al and presented to the Board of County Commissioners by yourself has been viewed and was brought before the Board of County Commissioners for action today.

We are willing to grant this road under the following conditions.

That a sixty foot right of way be furnished gratuitously to Gallatin County and that the parties benefited by drainage pay at the rate of \$300. per mile towards the drain ditch. This last request is made for the following reasons:-

It is our opinion that to construct a permanent road it will be necessary to use the County drag line and construct a drain ditch from the river to the present road along the bluff, and it has been customary wherever the county drag line is used under similar conditions that the people benefited by the drainage pay at the rate of \$300. per mile towards the cost of the work.

We ask that you take this up with the interested parties and see what can be done.
