We, the undersigned free holders of Road District No. 4..... of Gallatin County, Montana, residing on or adjacent to the following proposed County Road, do hereby petition your honorable

west half of the southeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, town-
ship 3 South, Range 4 East, said point being located N 00 degrees
45' E 100 feet from the southeast corner of said west half of the
southeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$); thence running northerly along the
east lines of the west half of the southeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$) and
the west half of the northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said section to
a point 1000 feet south of the northeast corner of the said west half
of the northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$)

ALSO we petition your honorable body to close the west half of the road
beginning at said point above described as being located 1000 feet south
of the northeast corner of the said west half of the northeast quarter
($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$), and thence running northerly 1000 feet to said northeast corner,
it being understood that a road 30 feet wide shall be left open through-
out this distance, the west boundary of said strip of road being the
east line of the said west half of the northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$)

Chapter 72, Thirteenth Session 1913, Sections 1-2-18

CHAPTER IV

Section 1. Any ten, or a majority, of the free holders of a road district, taxable therein for road purposes, may petition in writing, the Board of County Commissioners to, establish, change or discontinue any common highway therein. When such a highway is petitioned for upon the dividing line between two counties, the same course must be pursued as in other cases, except that a copy of the petition must be presented

to the Board of County Commissioners of each County, who may appoint viewers to act jointly and the viewers so appointed must report their findings to both Boards.

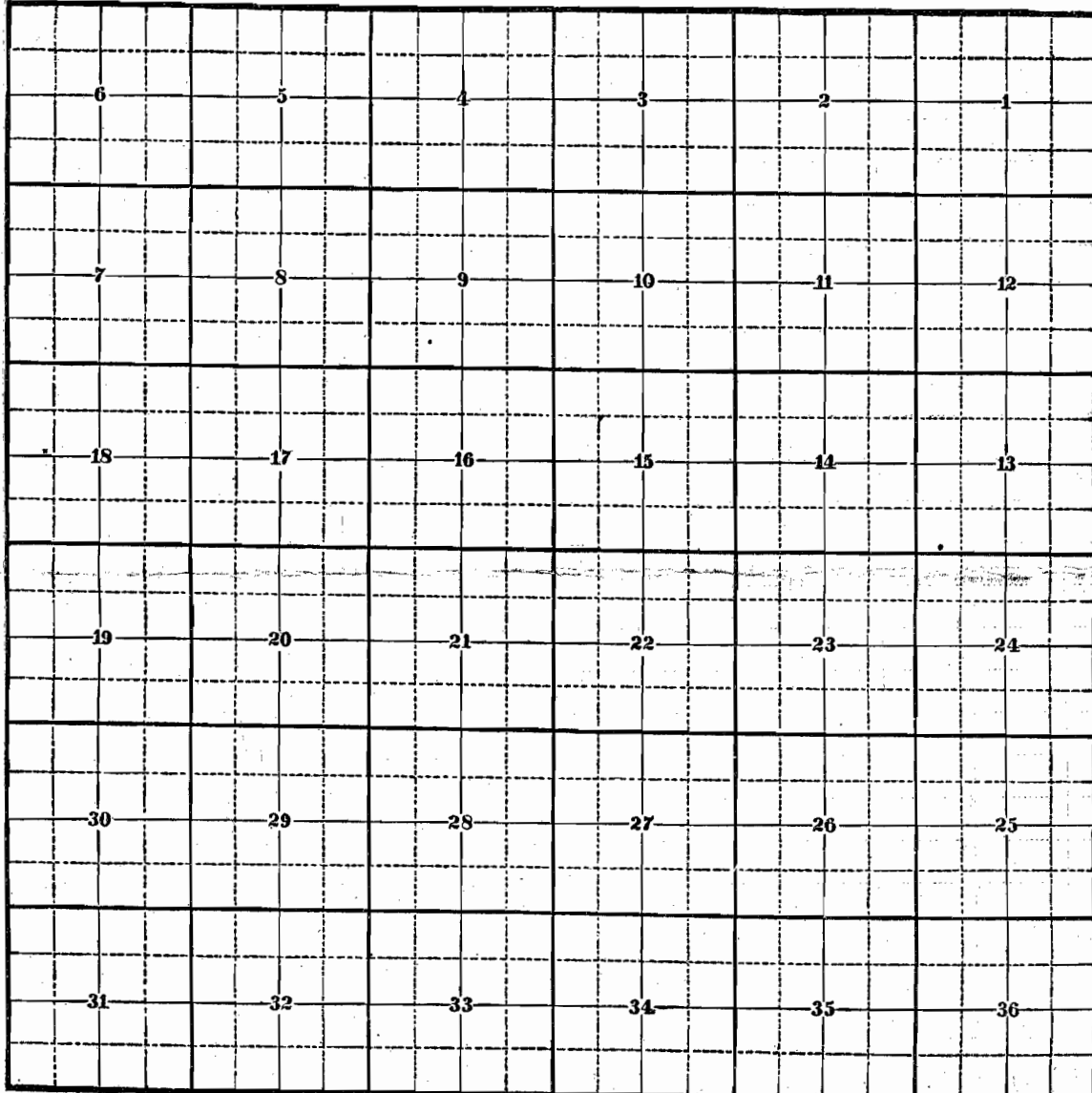
Section 2. The petition must be set forth and describe particularly the highways to be abandoned, discontinued, altered or constructed, and if the same is to be altered, laid-out or constructed, the general route thereof, over what lands, who are owners thereof, whether

such of them as can be found consent thereto, and if not the probable cost of the right-of-way, where consent is not had, the necessity for, and advantage of the proposed road.

Section 18. Highways must be laid out and opened when practicable or upon subdivision or section lines, Provided, however, that the section shall not be construed to prevent oads being laid out on diagonal lines when public purposes shall be best subserved thereby.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That a Petition was filed with the Board of County Commissioners, signed by ten freeholders taxable in Road District No. 4, which Petition was in writing and prayed for the abandonment of that certain highway described as follows:-

Beginning at the road intersection located at a point on the east line of the west half of the southeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, township 3 South, Range 4 East, said point being located N 00 degrees 45' E 100 feet from the southeast corner of said west half of the southeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$); thence running northerly along the east lines of the west half of the southeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$) and the west half of the northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said section to a point 1000 feet south of the northeast corner of the said west half of the northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$).

ALSO the west half of the road beginning at said point above described as being located 1000 feet south of the northeast corner of the said west half of the northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$), and thence running northerly 1000 feet to said northeast corner, it being understood that a road 30 feet wide shall be left open throughout this distance, the west boundary of said strip of road being the east line of the said west half of the northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$).

That, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, held at the court house in the city of Bezean, on the 1st day of July, 1924, the said Board of County Commissioners caused an investigation to be made into the feasibility and desirability of granting the prayer of said Petition and did, then and there, cause such investigation to be had as was deemed necessary to properly determine the merits of said Petition and that, thereupon, a member of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Surveyor viewed said premises and made a complete investigation as to the feasibility and desirability of abandoning said highway and did then and there order the abandonment of said highway and did further order that notice of such decision be sent by registered mail to the parties interested therein of their findings on said petition, and did further order that three copies of such Notice be posted in three conspicuous places along said abandoned highway.
