GENTLEMEN: -


We your viewers appointed for Road #542, wished to report as follows:-

- (1) That we viewed said road on March 19,1925, and found that this road is needed as a public highway for entrance to the Hamilton Cemetery, and would also be serviceable as an outlet for several ranches;
- (2) That a road could be constructed on this location at very small cost, the ground being level so that all work could be done with a blade grader, and only two small culverts being required for drainage;
- (3) That we recommend that this road be constructed and opened as a public highway provided , however, that all fencing be done and all right of way--40 feet in width-- be furnished by the signers of the petition without cost to Gallatin County.
