

VIEWER'S REPORT ON ROAD PETITION NO. 555.

To the Board of County Commissioners,

Gallatin County, Montana,
We the undersigned viewers appointed for Road Petition
Number 555 wish to report as follows:-

(1) That we viewed the proposed road route on July 14.1927.

(2) That we found the following conditions existing:-

(a) The portion of the proposed road leading from a point on Road \$422 southwesterly across portions of Sections 1.2, and 11.728 R2E, a distance of approximately 14 miles to a point near the West 1/16 corner of the NW2 of Section 11, would run down a steep hill at the eastern end of the location, and the best route for the road at this place could be determined only by survey; the balance of the road on this section would be of inexpensive construction;

(b) the portion of the proposed road running south from the West 1/16 corner of Section 11 to a junction with road No. 524 on the South Line of Section 10, a distance of approximately 7/8 miles has a private road already built approximately on the proposed route; this private road could be widened and used along part of the way, and the

entie sestion could be constructed wothout great expense;

(e) The road if established would furnish a valuable connecting link---along with Road #524--- between the Virginia City Road and Road #522, and would permit of mail service to many renches.

(3) We recommend that a survey be ordered to determine the most feasible route and the cost of construction, and that, provided the cost is not considered excessive, that the road be constructed in 1928, provided, however, that all rights of way and fencing required are furnished free of expense to Gallatin County.
