

VIEWERS REPORT ON ROAD PETITION # 565.
To the Board of County Commissioners of Gallatin County Montana:-

We, your viewers, appointed to view the road designated in Petition #565, wish to report as follows:-

- (1) That we viewed the location of the said proposed road on Nov. 15, 1928;
- (2) That we found the following: (a) That the said proposed road would in the main be used by only two ranches, and would be a dead-end road; and
- (b) That, exclusive of fencing and right of way, it would cost approximately \$350.00 to cinstruct this road according to county standards:
- (3) That we find and recommend as follows:-(a) That, in our opinion, the cost of this road exceeds the amount of benefit to be gained by the general public; (b) that, if shut off from the present road by the closing of their present method of egress, the owners of the two ranches in question have recourse to law in order to procure a private road by condemnation, as has been done in similar cases---and many private roads existing in this county today in similar places; (c) That this petition be denied;
