Chapter 72, Thirteenth Session 1913, Sections 1-2-18

CHAPTER IV

Section 1. Any ten, or a majority, of the free holders of a road district, taxable therein for road purposes, may petition in writing, the Board of County Commissioners to, establish, change or discontinue any common highway therein. When such a highway is petitioned for upon the dividing line between two counties, the same course must be pursued as in other cases, except that a copy of the petition must be presented

to the Board of County Commissioners of each County, who may appoint viewers to act jointly and the viewers so appointed must report their findings to both Boards.

Section 2. The petition must be set forth and describe particularly the highways to be abandoned, discontinued, altered or constructed, and if the same is to be altered, laid-out or constructed, the general route thereof, over what lands, who are owners thereof, whether

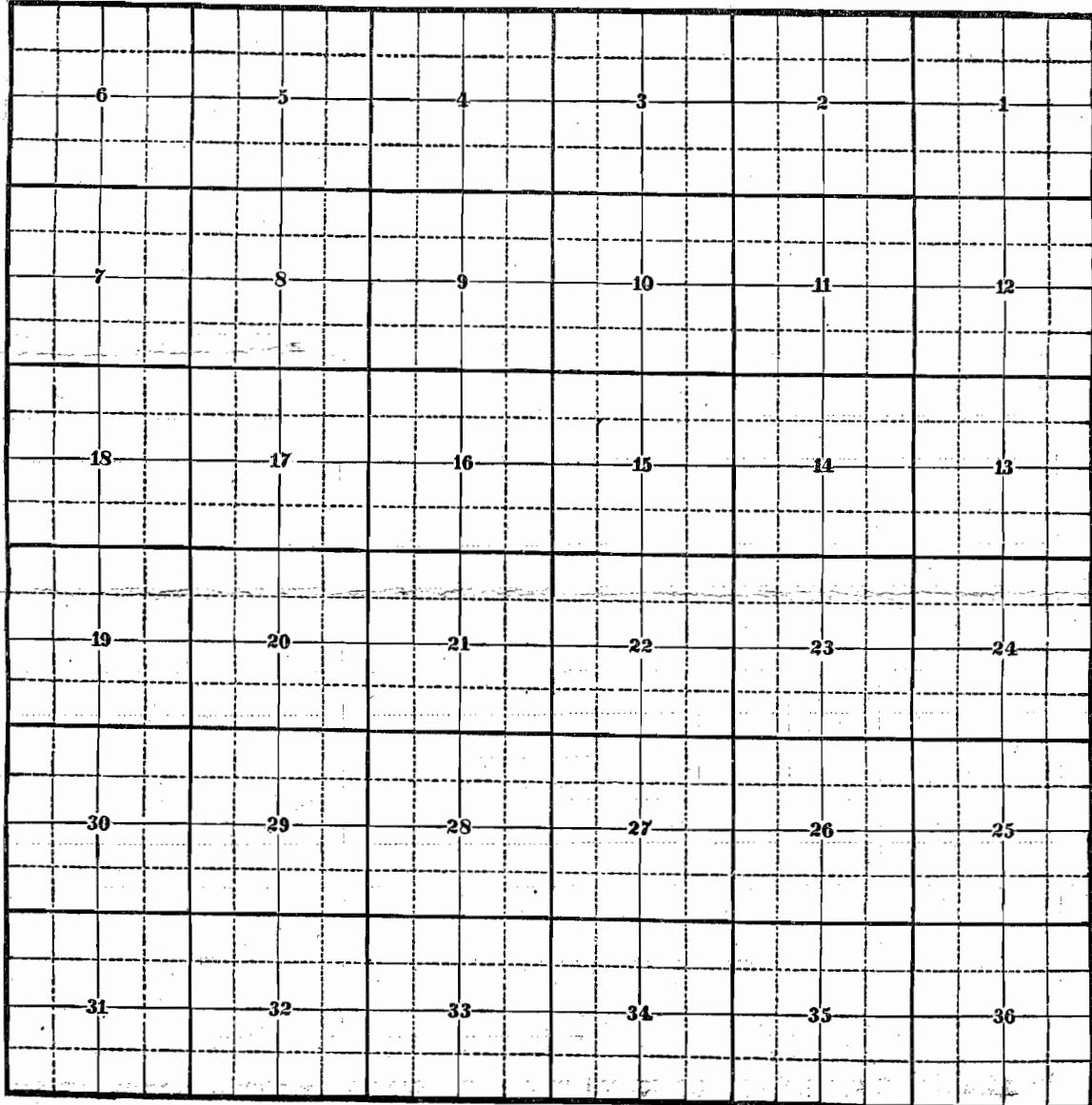
such of them as can be found consent thereto, and if not the probable cost of the right-of-way, where consent is not had, the necessity for, and advantage of the proposed road.

Section 18. Highways must be laid out and opened when practicable or upon subdivision or section lines, Provided, however, that the section shall not be construed to prevent oads being laid out on diagonal lines when public purposes shall be best subserved thereby.

**West Gallatin Reconstruction & Surfacing #5224
National Forest Highway**

That part, piece or parcel of ground in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33, T. 4 S., R. 3 E. for right-of-way purposes for line change on the West Gallatin Reconstruction & Surfacing Project #5224, National Forest Road; a strip of land 60' wide measured 30' on each side of the center line hereinafter described beginning at a point (Station 355/04.5 of the Location Survey of said Highway), said point lies 539.2' more or less due south, thence S55°08' E. for a distance of 405.9' more or less, *from the Northwest Corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 33,* thence beginning at the above mentioned point and continuing on a 10° curve to the right (Radius 575.0') for a distance of 370.0' more or less, thence continuing on a course of approximately S 16°08' E for a distance of 190.5' more or less, thence on a 4° curve (Radius 1452.5') to the left for a distance of approximately 40.6' to a point on South Boundary Line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33, T. 4 S., R. 3 E., said point lies in a westerly direction a distance of 87.0' more or less from SE Cor. of W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33. Said tract contains .328 acres more or less.

National Forest Highway

That part, piece or parcel of ground in the $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 33, T. 4 S., R. 4 E., for right-of-way purposes for line change of the West Gallatin Reconstruction and Surfacing Project #3224, National Forest Road; a strip of land sixty feet (60') wide, thirty (30) feet on each side of ~~centerline~~ centerline hereinafter described beginning at a point (Station 345/25.0 of the location survey of said Highway); said point lies approximately 311.6' south and approximately 86.8' east of NE Cor. of $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33.

Thence continuing on a course of approximately S. 29° 38' E. for a distance of 580.6' more or less, thence on a 10° curve (Radius 1432.6) to the right for approximately 232.8', thence continuing on an approximate course of S. 1° 21' E. for a distance of 1557.0' more or less, thence on a 4° curve (Radius 573.0) to the left for a distance of 252.9' more or less to a point which lies on the centerline of existing road.
