To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Gallatin Co., Mont.

Gentlemen:-

We the undersigned are residents and taxpayers in Gallatin County, Montana; and we are the owners of all lands abutting on both sides of the Streets in the Townsite of Central Park, Montana, hereinafter mentioned; that said Streets have not been worked, kept up or used, or needed as streets or highways at any time for about Twenty years last past, and the same have been allowed and permitted to grow up in grass and high weeds, which when dead and dry make a great menace in the nature of fires.

The streets in question are "High" St. from the West line of Block One (1) to the East line of said Block One (1), and all of "Cockrell" St., all in the Townsite of Central Park, Gallatin County, Montana; and we respectfully ask that said Streets to the extent mentioned be declared abandoned, discontinued and vacated, and the land embraced therein be restored to the abutting owners.

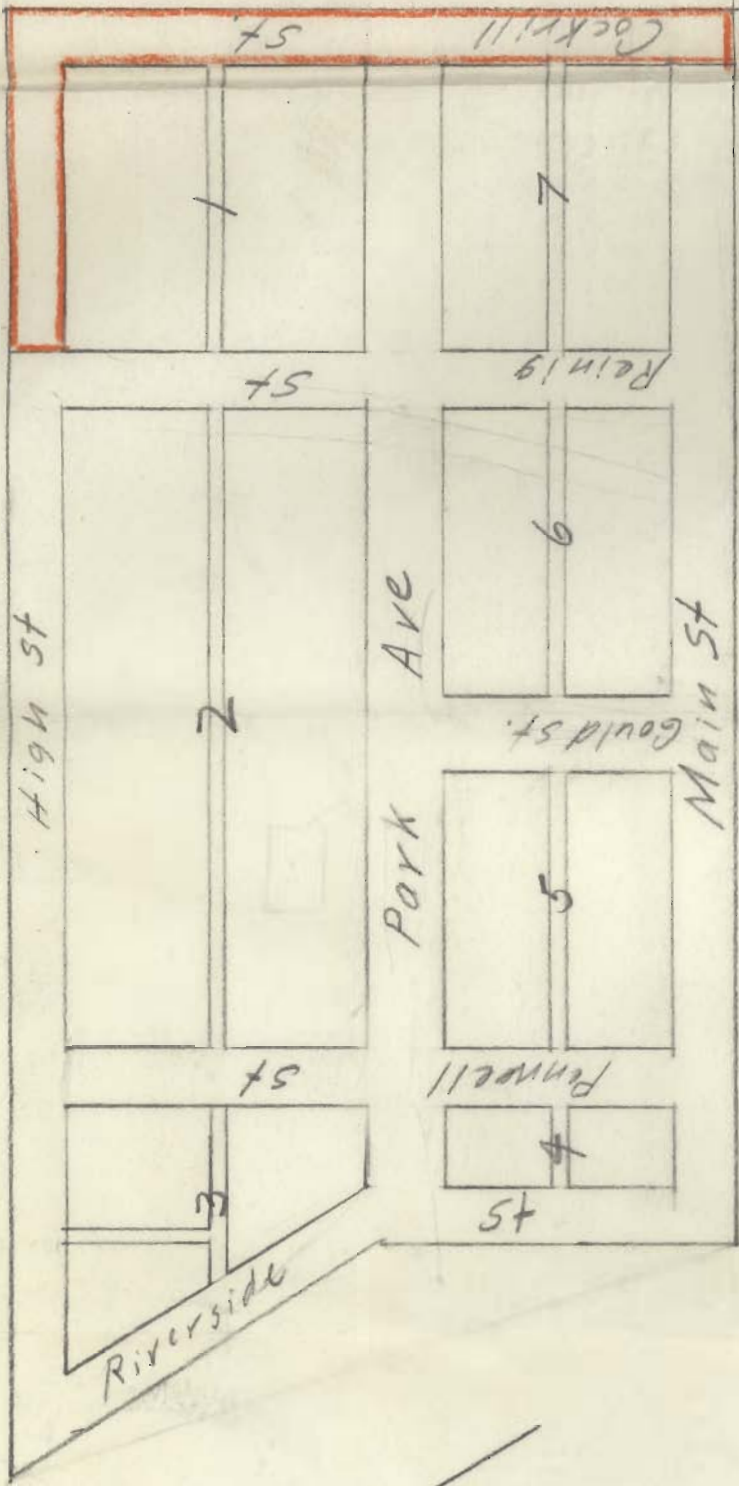
