

VIEWERS' REPORT ON ROAD #572

To the Board of County Commissioners, Bozeman, Montana.

Gentlemen:

We, your viewers appointed to view Road #572, wish to report that we viewed said road on October 29th, 1930 and found the following conditions existing:

- (1) That said road would run along the C.,M.,St.P. & Pac. right-of-way from Sappington to the new State Highway between Sappington and Harrison, a distance of approximately one-half mile, and that said road would be the most practical way of reaching the State Highway from Sappington.
- (2) The Railroad Company is willing to give the right-of-way specified only that the center of the road must be placed 35 feet from the center line of the high-tension pole line running parallel to the railroad track.
- (3) Grading for the most part can be done with a truck and grader, fresno work being required inna few places.
- (4) Such drainage and irrigation structures as are required are small and inexpensive.

We recommend the following:

- (1) That said Petition be granted.
- (2) That bruck and grader unit #9 be ordered to do the blading work at once and that Supervisor Woodward be ordered to do the fresno and culvert work at once so that this road may be Opened to traffic before winter weather sets in.
