PETITION FOR ABANDONING A

PUBLIC HIGHWAY 1

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:-

GENTLEMEN:-

We, the undersigned freeholders of Road District No. 5, do hereby petition your honorable body to abandon as a public highway the following described County Road:

Beginning at the intersection of the North Line of U.S. No. 10 State Highway with the old Yellowstone Trail Highway at a point in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-four (24), of Township Two South (T2S), Range Six East (R6E), P.M.M., Gallatin County, Montana, thence N 50°33' E a distance of 170 feet; thence N 80°00' E a distance of 178 feet; thence N 63°11' E, a distance of 100 feet, more or less, to a point 10 feet Northeast of the bridge over Rocky Creek; said described County Road crossing the tracks of the Northern Pacific Railway.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That it is proposed to abandon the following described highway as a public road:

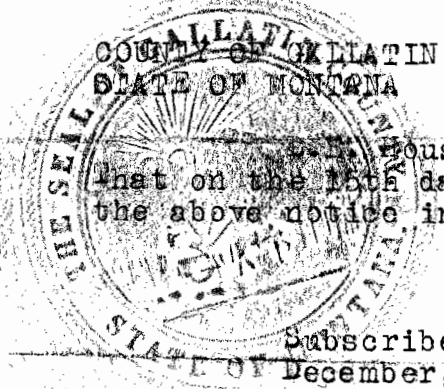

No. 10 State Highway with the old Yellowstone Trail Highway at a point in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup>) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Two South (T2S), Range Six East (R6E), P.M.M., Gallatin County, Montana, thence N 50° 33' E, a distance of 170 feet; thence N 80° 00' E, a distance of 178 feet; thence N 63° 11' E, a distance of 100 feet, more or less, to a point 10 feet Northeast of the bridge over Rocky Creek; said described County Road crossing the tracks of the Northern Pacific Railway.

Hearing on the above matter will be held by the Board of County Commissioners at two o'clock P. M. on the 17th day of December, 1934 at the Court House at Bozeman, Montana, at which time the Commissioners will determine the merits of said matter finally, and, at which time all persons interested may make objections or offer suggestions relative to the abandonment of said highway.

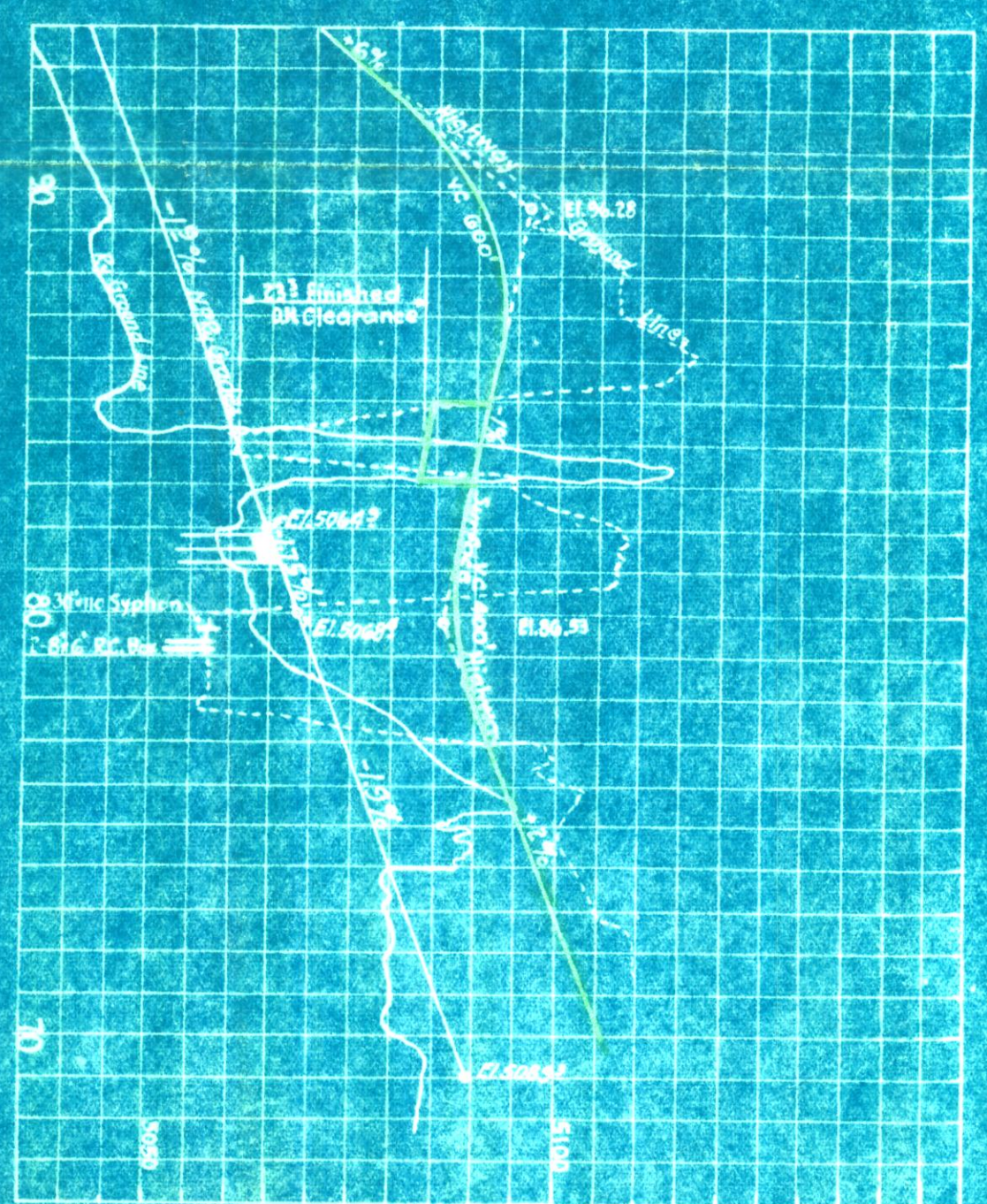
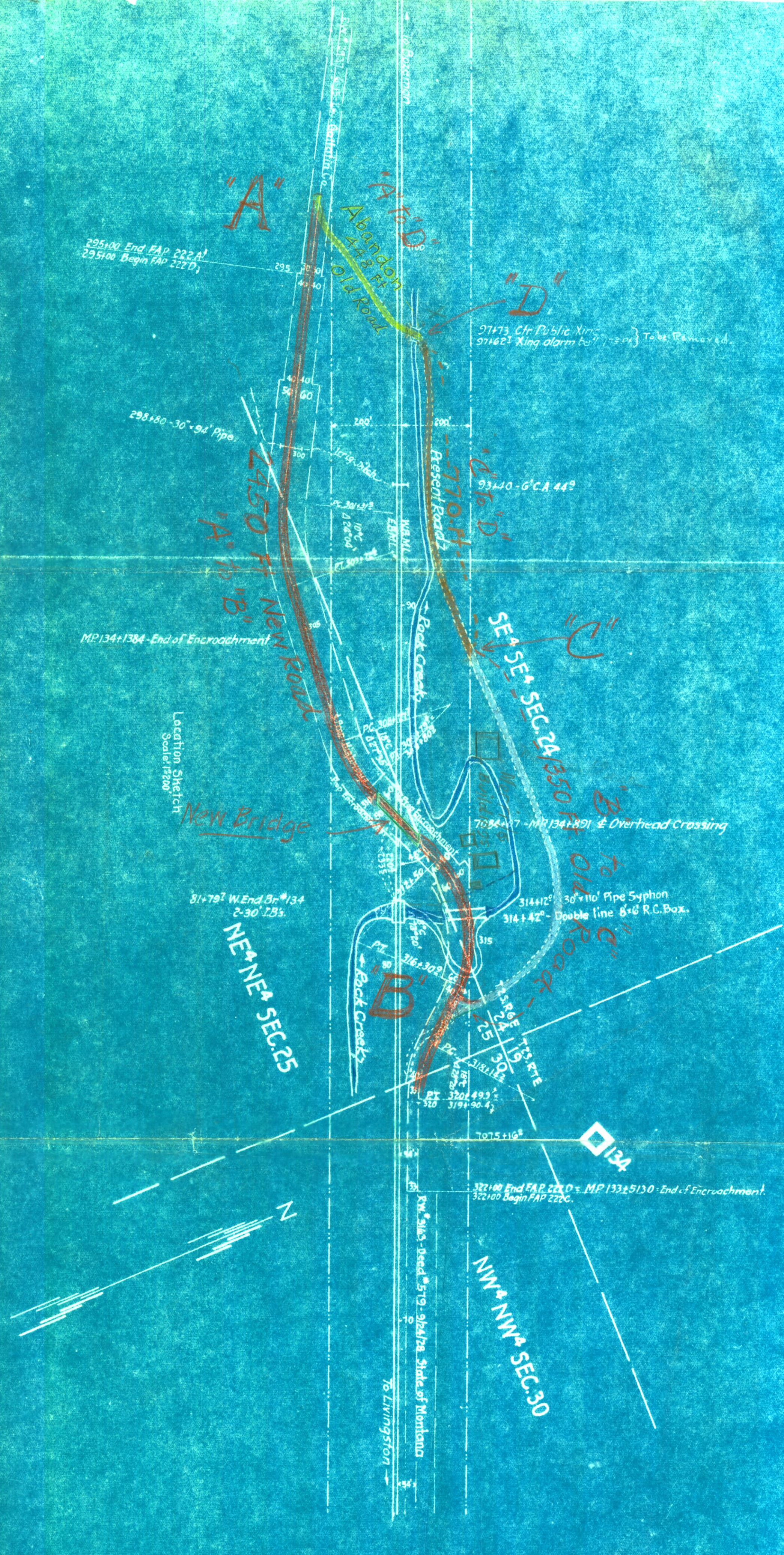
