PETITION FOR ABANDONING A
PUBLIC HIGHWAY

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:-

GENTLEMEN:-

We, the undersigned freeholders of Road District No.13,
do hereby petition your honorable body to abandon as a public
highway the following described County Road:

Beginning at a point on the west line of the south half
of Section 10, of Township Thirteen South (T13S), Range Four East,
(R4E) P.M.M., Gallatin County, Montana, said point being where the
old County Road crosses said West line, thence N.31°57'E., 1321 ft.,
thence N.17°53'E. 2540 ft., thence N.77°53'E. 805 ft. to a point
on the Lake Shore 300 feet west of the north quarter corner of said
section 10.

This road is no longer needed as a Public Road as the
Forestry Department has built a new road which is serving the
vicinity in a satisfactory manner.

We have drawn the petition asking for the closing of the entire road from the point where the new road leaves the old road, to the lake, as the county would not want to have a small piece of road left out there all by itself.

The law requires that the petition must have at least ten freeholders' signatures on it. When signed it should be sent to the Board of County Commissioners at Bozeman.

NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF HIGHWAY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That it is proposed to abandon the following described highway as a public road:

Beginning at a point on the west line of the South half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Ten (10), Township Thirteen South (T13S), Range Four East, (R4E), P.M.M., Gallatin County, Montana, said point being where the old County road crosses said West line, thence N. 31° 57' E. 1321 ft., thence N. 17° 53' E. 2540 ft., thence N. 77° 53' E. 805 ft., to a point on the Lake Shore.

Hearing on the above matter will be held by the Board of County Commissioners at two o'clock P. M. on the 20th day of December, 1934 at the Court House at Bozeman, Montana, at which time the Commissioners will determine the merits of said matter finally, and, at which time all persons interested may make objections or offer suggestions relative to the abandonment of said highway.
