NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF HIGHWAY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That it is proposed to abandon the following described highway as a public road:

Beginning at the East Quarter (E $\frac{1}{4}$) corner of Section One (1), Township One (1) North, Range One (1) East, thence West one (1) mile to the West Quarter (W $\frac{1}{4}$) corner of said Section One (1).

Hearing on the above matter will be held by the Board of County Commissioners at two o'clock P. M. on the 10th day of February, 1941 at the Court House at Bozeman, Montana, at which time the Commissioners will determine the merits of said matter finally, and at which time all persons interested may make objections or offer suggestions relative to the abandonment of said highway.
