NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF STREETS AND
ALLEY IN TOWN OF WILLOW CREEK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That it is proposed to abandon the following described streets and alley as public streets and alley in the Town of Willow Creek, Montana:

All of that portion of Fourth Street lying west of the West line of Main Street; all of that portion of Green Street lying between the North line of Fifth Street and the North line of Lot 13 of Block 9 of the Original Plat of the Town of Willow Creek; also that portion of the alley between Main Street and Green Street, lying between the north line of Fourth Street and the North line of Lots 11 and 13 of said Block 9, said portion being 50 feet from Fourth Street to said North line of Lots 11 and 13.

Hearing on the above matter will be held by the Board of County Commissioners at ten o'clock A. M. on the 13th day of February, 1941 at the Court House in Bozeman, Montana, at which time the Commissioners will determine the merits of said matter finally, and, at which time all persons interested may make objections or offer suggestions relative to the abandonment of said streets and alley.

Dear Sir:-

In reply to your letter of Jan. 8, 1941, addressed to the Clerk & Recorder in regard to the closing of a portion of an Alley and a portion of Fourth St. and Green Street, we wish to say that in 1928 the Trustees of Willow Creek School District No. 15 purchased Lots 11 -12 and 13 of Block 9 of the Original Plat of Willow Creek, as shown on the enclosed plat.

Soon afterwards they fenced off the Alley West of Main St., on the North line of Lots 11 and 13 and used the ground as a school playground, including that part of Fourth St. west of Main St. This ground has been used as a playground for the last 10 years and the Alley has been closed to the Public all this time. Green St. is on the west side of the school and has a slough running along it as shown on the plat. This has always been closed. Those portions proposed to be closed are shown in color on this plat.

The School Board and the County Commissioners wish to clear the records and according to law, must officially notify all interested parties. To clear the record The County Commissioners have to hold a hearing on the

matter and as long as this alley has been closed for at least 10 years, with no protest from the property owners in this block, they thought they should take official action. They do not wish to decrease the value of any lots by so doing.

We note that Lot 10 is still on record in the Records Office in the name of Elsie Tinsley, altho the Assessor has it assessed to Mrs. W.E.Moser. You mentioned in your letter, a lot as being recorded in your wife's name and we thought perhaps you did not realize that your Deed had not been recorded.

We hope this is the information that you desired, and that you understand the reason for official closing this alley and these streets. We assure you we are not trying to cut any one off from their lots, as they have been closed to the public so many years.

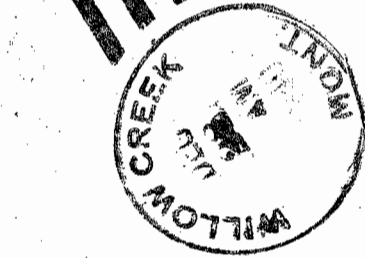
