Gentlemen:

The Board is considering the abandonment of County Road #108, known as the old Anceney-Vincent Road, starting at a point one-fourth mile south of the Vincent School, thence in a southerly direction over the hill through the South half ($s\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Four (4) and through the West half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of Sections Nine (9) and Ten (10) and the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), all of Township Two South (T2S), Range Three East (R3E), to the intersection of the Bozeman-Norris gravel road at a point three-fourths mile west of the Anceney School, a distance of approximately three (3) miles.

A hearing will be conducted by this Board on Monday, December 15th, at ten o'clock A. M., at which time any interested person will be heard, either for or against the abandonment of this road.

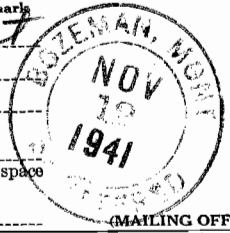
