NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF HIGHWAY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That it is proposed to abandon the following described highway as a public road:

beginning at the southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, T2N, R3E; thence north-easterly through parts of Sections 23, 14, 13 and 12 of T2N, R3E; and Sections 7, 8 and 5, T2N, R3E, to a point on the west line of Section 5, T2N, R3E.

Hearing on the above matter will be held by the Board of County Commissioners at two o'clock P. M. on the 20th day of November, 1945 at the Court House in Bozeman, Montana, at which time the Commissioners will determine the merits of said matter finally, and, at which time all persons interested may make objections or offer suggestions relative to the abandonment of said highway.

Dear Mr. Devries:

After considering Road Petition No. 594 requesting the abandonment of a County road running from the Clarkston road northeasterly through Sections 23, 14, 13 and 12, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, and Sections 7, 6 and 5, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, the Board decided to deny the petition and rule that said road must be left open as a public road.

The Board, however, will permit stock-guards to be constructed on this road by those owners who desire to construct them, in order to save themselves the expense of fencing along the sides of this road. The stock-guards must be built at the owner's expense and according to instructions obtained from the County Surveyor's office.
