We, the undersigned, appointed as Road Viewers on Road Petition No. 599, which petition requests that the Board of County Commissioners abandon and vacate as a public road the County Road described in said Petition, wish to report as follows:

1. The Board, as Viewers on Road No. 17, wish to report that they viewed Road No. 17 as per Petition No. 599, this date;
2. Found the right-of-way between fences only 32 feet wide, and from the fences on the West side to an irrigating ditch on the East side of the road, only 20 feet. The road is too narrow to put up a grade and, it being low, it is passable only part of the time on account of the water condition when irrigating is on;
3. We recommend that a hearing be held, as required by law, at which interested parties may appear and the Board of County Commissioners finally determine whether or not said road should be vacated as a public road.
