Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned freeholders of Gallatin County, taxable therein for road purposes, do hereby petition your Honorable Body to establish as a County Road the following described road:

Beginning at a point in the South line of Section Four (4), Township Two (2) North, Range Seven (7) East, which point is 200 feet, more or less, East of the South Quarter ($S\frac{1}{4}$) corner of said Section Four (4); thence in a northeasterly direction along a gravelly ridge and just to the West of the Sedan Cemetery, to a point on the East line of said Section Four (4), just South of the Sedan School House. Total distance 5,000 feet, more or less.

We further petition your honorable body to vacate as public roads the following road in case the above proposed road is established:

Beginning at a point on the South line of Section Four (4), Township Two (2) North, Range Seven (7) East, said point being 1,326 feet East of the South Quarter ($S\frac{1}{4}$) corner of said Section Four (4); thence from said point of beginning N. $27\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East, a distance of 3,057 feet, thence North along the East line of Said Section Four (4), a distance of 1,443, feet, more or less. Total distance of 4,500 feet, more or less.
