Beginning at a point near the Northeast corner of Section Six (6), Township One (1) South, Range Three (3) East; thence west along the North line of Section Six (6), thence in a Northwesterly direction through Section Thirty-six (36), Township One (1) North, Range Two (2) East, to a point on the North line of Section Thirty-six (36), a distance of approximately Two and three-eighths (2 3/8) miles.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners
Of Gallatin County, State of Montana:

We, W. C. Papke, as acting County Surveyor of Gallatin County, State of Montana on December 10, 1954 and County Commissioner George L. Stucky viewed the proposed road which is described in Petition No. 607:-

" Beginning at a point near the Northeast corner of Section Six (6), Township One (1) South, Range Three (3) East; thence West along the north line of Section Six (6); thence in a northwesterly direction through Section Thirty-six (36) Township One (1) North, Range Two (2) East to a point on the north line of said Section Thirty-six (36), a distance of approximately Two and 3/8 miles. "

We found (1) That there no families or persons living adjacent to the above described road:

(2) That during farming operations each year is the only time said road has to be used:

(3) There appears to be no livestock, due to lack of water, on land adjacent to said road:

(4) That the present road is sufficient to haul crops to market:

(5) That there is a County Road at present to the northwest corner of section thirty-six, and a county road to the point of beginning on the north line of section Six:

(6) That construction of this road would require a right of way from the State of Montana, which calls for a survey, plat and description of land taken by right of way through each forty-acre tract: plus cost per acre:

(7) That it would be necessary to construct a 10 foot span bridge and several drainage culverts:

(8) That it does not seem necessary for public use and convenience:

Now, in view of the foregoing facts, We recommend that said road should not be constructed.

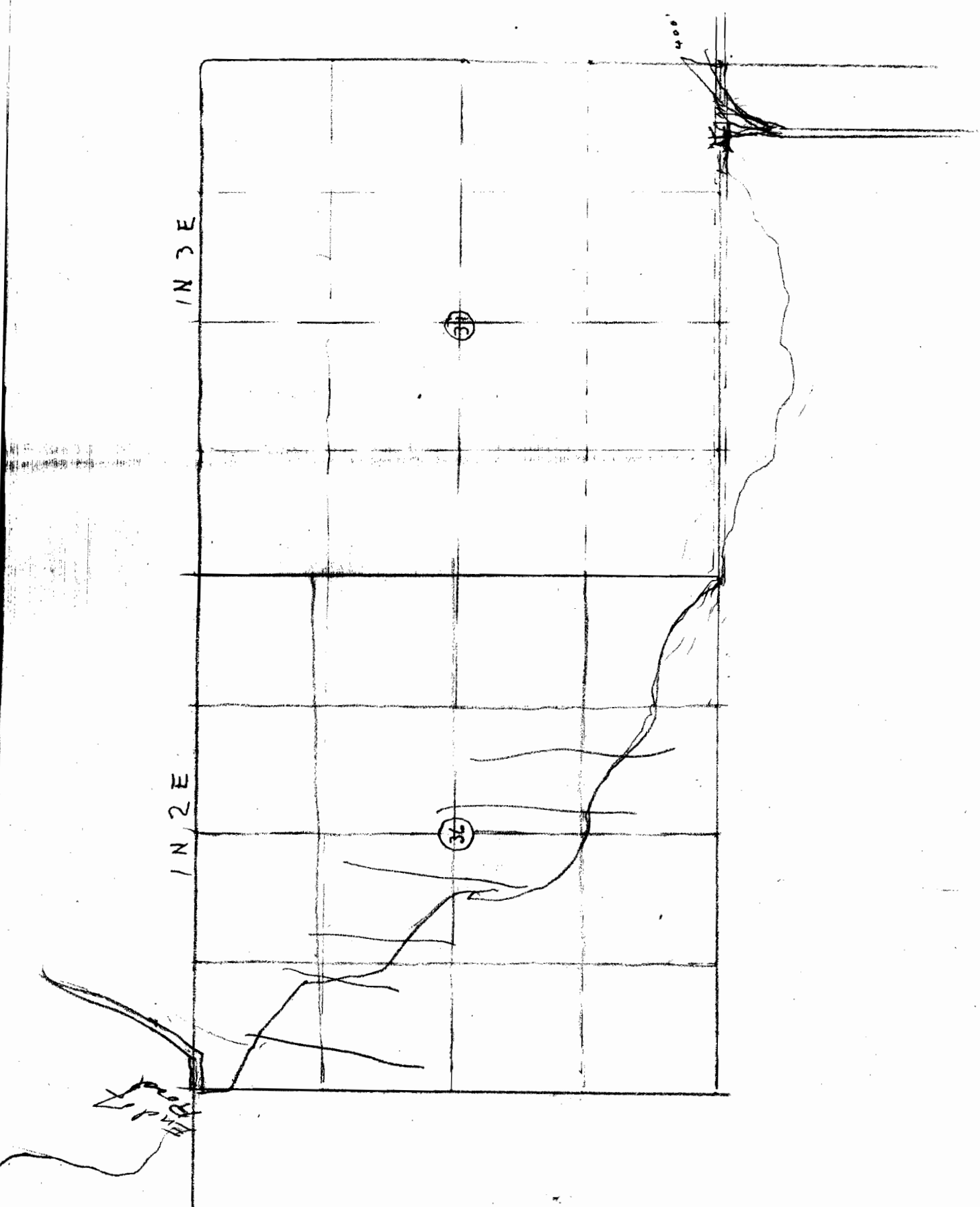
