No. 611

To the Honorable Board of
County Commissioners of
Gallatin County, Montana

Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned freeholders of Gallatin County, taxable
therein for road purposes, do hereby petition your Honorable Body to
establish as a County Road the following described road:

Beginning at a point, approximately 1300 feet East
of the West quarter corner of Section 21, T.1N.,
R.5E.; thence southeasterly along and parallel to
the right of way of the Gallatin Valley branch of
the C.M.St P. & P. Ry., a distance of 2000 feet, more
or less, to Road No. 106, at a point on the South
line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast
Quarter of Section 21.

We further petition your honorable body to vacate as public
roads the following road in case the above proposed road is estab-
lished:

That portion of Road No. 106, beginning at a point
on the Southwesterly right of way of the Gallatin
Valley Branch of the C.M.St.P. & P. Ry., said point
being approximately 1300 ft. East of the West Quarter
corner of Section 21, T.1N., R.5E.; thence South 1354
feet, thence East 1450 feet, more or less, to a point
on the Southwesterly right of way of said Gallatin
Valley Branch.

Gentlemen:

We, W. C. Papke, as Acting County Surveyor of Gallatin County, and George L. Stucky, County Commissioner of Gallatin County, viewed the road described in Road Petition No. 611, and report as follows:

That the road intended to be vacated is narrow and in low ground, there being a large dragline ditch on one side of the road thus leaving a narrow right of way for the road; That the road intended to be opened as described in said petition is for the most part of higher ground and when completed would make a more serviceable all weather road; we also recommend that the road to be opened be sixty feet in width adjacent to and parallel to the southwesterly side of the right-of-way of the Gallatin Valley Branch of the Milwaukee Railroad. We further recommend that the road as described in the petition be vacated and closed in favor of the road to be opened.
