The blacktop was torn up badly when the new highway was under construction with the bulldozers and heavy equipment running constantly on it during the hot weather. However we have since then kept it repaired, filling in many holes and repairing damaged areas.

NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF A
PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY

Board of County Commissioners
Gallatin County
Bozeman, Montana

Statement:

Please be advised that the State Highway Commission in regular session May 24, 1965, conformable to Opinion No. 137, Volume 23, Official Opinions of the Attorney General of Montana, dated December 1, 1950, officially abandoned the following described section of highway as a part of the State Highway System, since it has been replaced and superseded by a more recently constructed section of said Highway System:

All that portion of the former Forest Highway Project No. 46-A1 beginning on the west line of Homestead Entry Survey No. 795 at Highway Survey Station 47½ of FNP 46-A1, thence easterly 2500 feet, more or less, to a point on the 200' setback line of FNP 46-A1 at Highway Survey Station 72½ in the ~~W1/4SW1/4~~ of Section 21, Township 13 South, Range 4 East, Gallatin County. The portion of highway proposed for abandonment traverses N.E.S. #795 and an unsurveyed portion of Section 20, and the ~~W1/4SW1/4~~ of Section 21, Township 13 South, Range 4 East.

The abandoned portion lies northerly of the present highway. In view of the action taken, the State Highway Commission will no longer administer the right of way as a part of the State Highway System. The maintenance of any structures on the abandoned portion, and maintenance of the roadway thereon have already been discontinued.

Dear Miss McNeil:

We have received your request to close a portion of the abandoned state highway which has reverted back to Gallatin County. In honor of this request, we are enclosing a petition which will accomplish this purpose. As soon as this is returned to our office, we will proceed in a lawful manner with this petition.
