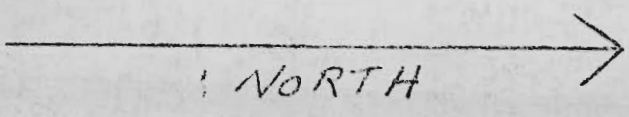
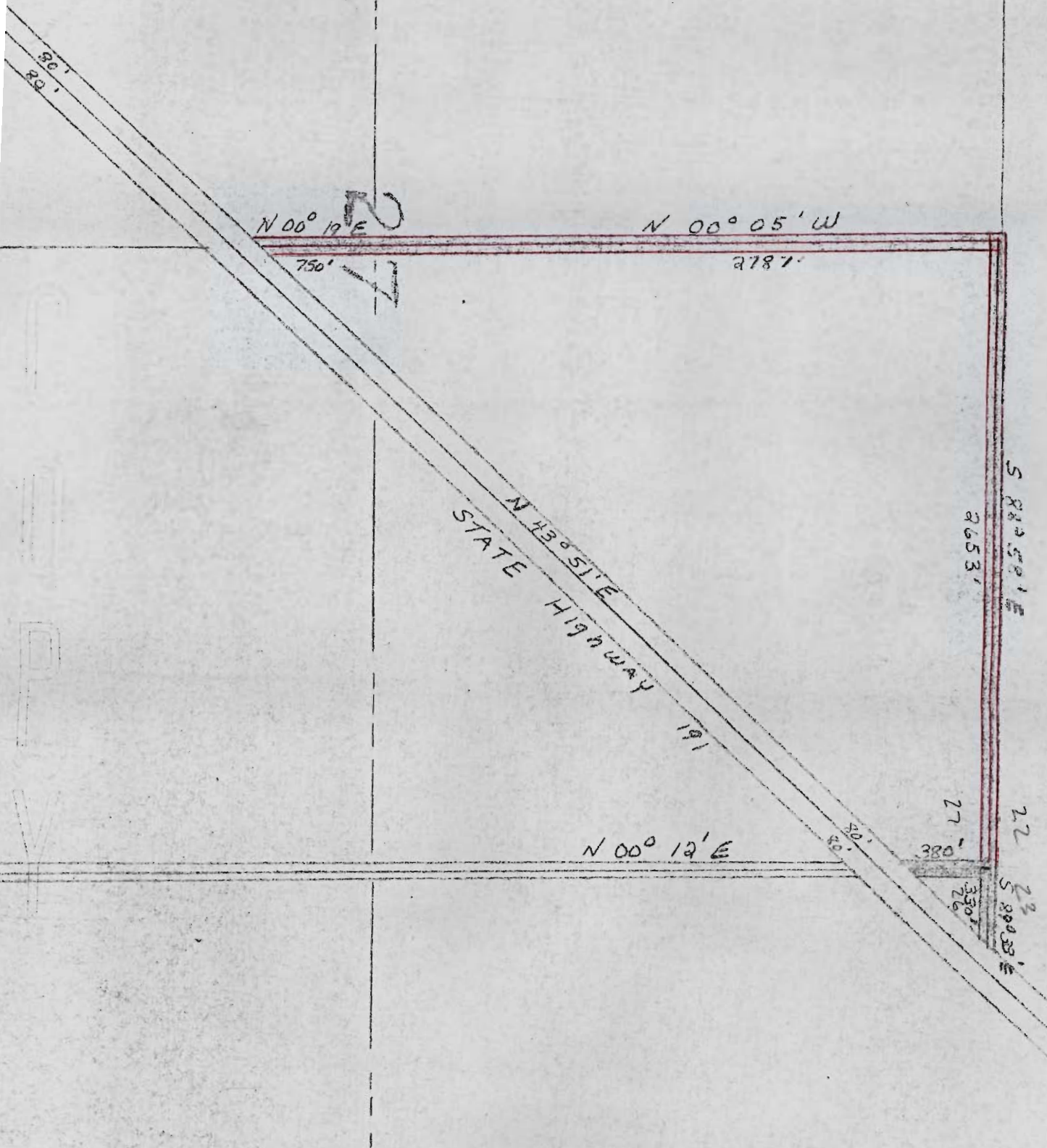

PETITION TO ABANDON ROAD

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,  
GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA.

Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned Freeholders of Gallatin County, taxable therein for road purposes, do hereby petition your Honorable Body to abandon as a public highway a road lying on the North-South centerline of Section 27 and on the North line of this Section and on the South line of Section 22, in Township 3 South, Range 4 East, the centerline of which is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on the North-South centerline of Section 27, Township 3 South, Range 4 East, at the northerly edge of the State Highway Road right-of-way number 191; thence North 00°19' East for a distance of 750 feet; thence North 00°05' West for a distance of 2787 feet, to the northerly line of Section 27 and the southerly line of Section 22; thence South 88°58' East for a distance of 2653 feet, which is on the south line of Section 22 and the North line of Section 27, in said Township and Range;

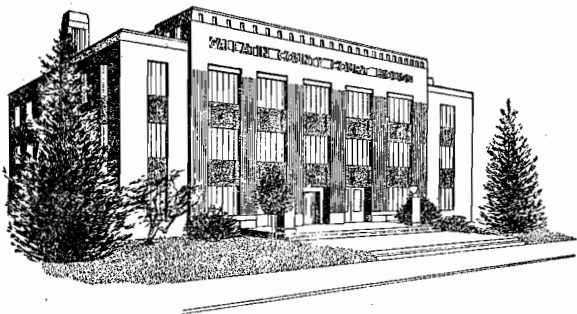

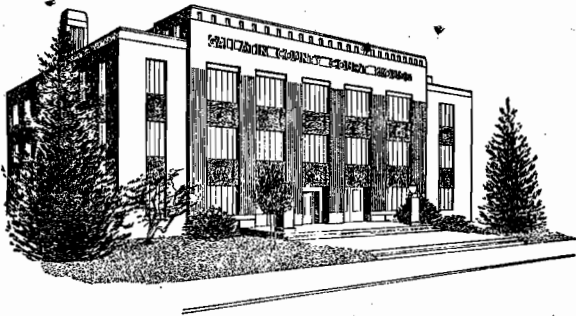
Petition #650 requesting abandon as public highway the road lying on the north-south centerline of Section 27 and the line between Section 27 and Section 22, in Township 3 South, Range 4 East, the centerline being more particularly described in the Petition #650.

On October 21, 1970, the reviewing board for the County of Gallatin, State of Montana whose authorized members consisted of Ralph W. Armstrong, County Commissioner and Earl R. Best, Professional Engineer and Land Surveyor, made inspection of the road petitioned to abandon for public use.

It is recommended by this Board that the County road in question be closed to public use from the northwesterly right of way of US Highway # 191 north along the centerline of Section 27 and east along the line between Sections 22 and 27 to a point 30 feet west of the section corner common to Sections 22, 23, 26 and 27, in Township 3 South Range 4 East for an approximate distance of 1.17 miles.
