PETITION FOR DISCONTINUATION OF STREET OR ALLEY

This petition is filed pursuant to Section 11-2801, R.C.M. 1947.

COMES NOW, the Board of Trustees of School District No. 35, Gallatin Gateway, Montana and petitions the County Commissioners of Gallatin County, Montana to abandon alley way in Block No. 14 from Webb Street to the east end of said alley according to the townsite and plat of the town of Gallatin Gateway, Gallatin County, Montana.

That the alleyway is to be closed for school purposes so that additional class rooms and playground facilities can be constructed. That the petitioners, the School District, own all of the lots on the portion of the alley which is the subject of this petition.



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 11-2802,
R.C.M. 1947, that a petition has been filed to close alley way
in Block 14 from Webb Street to the east end of said alley way
in the Town of Gallatin Gateway, Gallatin County, Montana according
to the plat on record in the Clerk and Recorder's office of
Gallatin County, Montana and a copy attached hereto as exhibit "A".

A hearing to act on the petition to close said alley way
shall be held in the office of the County Commissioners of Gallatin
County at the Courthouse, Bozeman, Montana on the 2nd day of May,
1978, at the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M. All persons with any
objections as to the closing of said alley way are to appear before
the Board of Commissioners to voice their objections, if any,
as to why the alley way should not be closed.

Said notice shall be posted in three public places
at least one week before the date of the hearing.

R E S O L U T I O N

THIS RESOLUTION introduced by Commissioner Nash, who moved its adoption, and it was seconded by Commissioner Sager, was unanimously passed and adopted,

WHEREAS, The Gallatin County Commissioners acting pursuant to their authority, granted by Section 11-2801 of the Revised Codes of Montana, 1947, received a petition from the Board of Trustees of School District No. 35, Gallatin Gateway, Montana which asked for the discontinuance of an alleyway in Block 14 from Webb Street to the East end of said alley;

WHEREAS, the Trustees as petitioner, are the sole owners of any lots on the alley which is to be discontinued;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have determined that the alley can be discontinued without detriment to the public interest;

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners have complied with the notice procedures of Section 11-2802, by posting notice of the hearing on the above-mentioned petition in three public places at least one week before the hearing;

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners held a hearing on the above-mentioned petition at 9:00 o'clock A.M., on May 2, 1978;


WHEREAS, at that hearing on May 2, 1978, to consider the above-mentioned petition to discontinue an alleyway in Block 14, in Gallatin Gateway, Montana, there were no protests to the petition at the hearing;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the alleyway in Block 14 from Webb Street to the East end of said alleyway, in the town of Gallatin Gateway, Montana be discontinued.


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that said alley is discontinued effective as of the date of this Resolution.
