Beginning at the North Section Line of said Section 8, Road Station 147 + 50(\pm), the true point of beginning of abandonment; thence Southerly through Sections 8, 7, 17, and 18 of Township 4 South of Range 4 East, to Station 260 + 03.5, being the end of said Williams Road No. 200 as shown in Book 51 C. M. Thorpe, falling at a point 440.2 feet North of the North Line of Section 20, Township 4 South of Range 4 East, P.M.M.

Total distance for road abandonment is 2-1/8 miles, more or less.


Members:

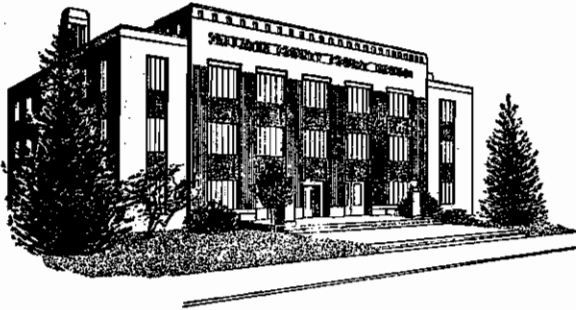
Because of the following reasons the viewers agree with the commissioners decision to abandon the road.

1. No physical evidence that the county has ever maintained the road.
2. That portion of the road running next to the river is unsafe.
3. Because the road has never been built the cost would be tremendously expensive for the county to construct.
4. It appears to the viewers that it would be detrimental to Gallatin County financially to retain said right-of-way.
5. Also there is no way the county could justify spending taxpayers money to serve two parties who have summer homes.
6. The road invites trespassing and infringement on private property rights which should be avoided if possible.
7. The Southerly portion of the road is a trail and any improvements on the road has been done by private parties.

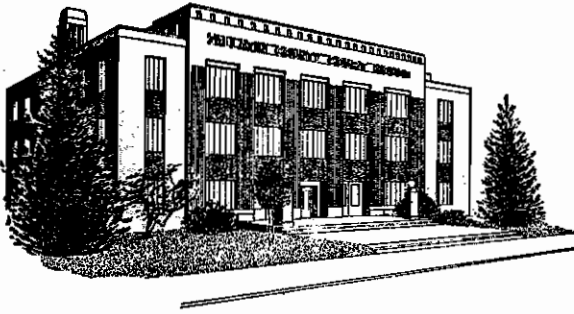

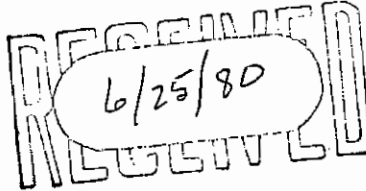

The purpose of this letter is to present the Gallatin National Forest position concerning Road Petition No. 700, which requests abandonment of the County road known as the Kleinschmidt Road or Williams Road No. 200.

The petitioned road is a single lane facility which in its present condition is drivable by passenger car from Interstate Highway 191 to an east-west fenceline located a few hundred feet north of Section 20. It appears that the fence was constructed in recent years and that in the past the road physically extended beyond the dedicated portion to the National Forest land in Section 20. Thus, a case could be made that in addition to the formal dedication, the public, through past unrestricted use, may have perfected rights by prescription beyond the existing fence to Section 20.

This existing public way presently affords the only potential roaded access route in the North Canyon area east of the Gallatin River. Its existence is important to National Forest administration in this area, and its loss would limit present and future management activities such as timber and wildlife management, public recreation, boundary line maintenance, and fire suppression.

Mountain pine beetle infestation is heavy in this portion of the Forest, and in an attempt to salvage the commercial material, two timber sales are proposed within the next five years. Both sales are tributary to the road, and the road would provide access for sale activities. The Forest Service would perfect any additional right-of-way easements connecting the existing facility with the National Forest.

By perfecting these additional easements to the National Forest, the public will be able to reach and enjoy the recreational amenities of the National Forest. Some of these recreational activities would include access to the Gallatin River for fishing, camping, picnicking, hunting, and access to the Sheep Rock Trail which runs from the north line of Section 20 to the Squaw Creek Administration Site.

In conjunction with the above National Forest activities, the Forest Service is willing to work with the County under the framework of our Cooperative Forest Road Development Agreement to insure that the facility receives adequate maintenance and that safety modifications are made such as the construction of occasional turnouts.

We do not envision that public use in this area will be heavy, but nevertheless, any potential access to public land is important and should be maintained. As you are aware, loss of access to public lands is an increasing problem in Gallatin County. Maintaining this public facility would be consistent with the County Outdoor Recreation and Open Space Plan which addresses this concern on page 3, Problem #3C: "In cases where possible and appropriate, it is recommended that the County work on a cooperative basis with other agencies to acquire location and attendant parking facilities for additional access to public lands."

Therefore we request that the petition be denied and that exclusive use of this area not be permitted, which is contrary to local public needs.

Total distance for road abandonment is 2-1/8 miles, more or less.


It is our feeling that Gallatin County in cooperation with the U. S. Forest Service and the Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks can with this road provide public access to public lands (Forest Service) for the purposes of hunting, hiking, cross-country skiing, etc. plus public access to the Gallatin River for fishing and floating. This goal would be consistent with the stated goals of the Gallatin County Commission in the recently published Outdoor Recreation and Open Space Plan for Gallatin County. Retaining this road as a public access to public land and the Gallatin River would require little or no additional expense for the county, but would be beneficial to the general public of the entire county and state as well as many of our non-resident visitors. We strongly encourage you to consider the public's need in this instance rather than the few individuals who may be benefited by the road abandonment.

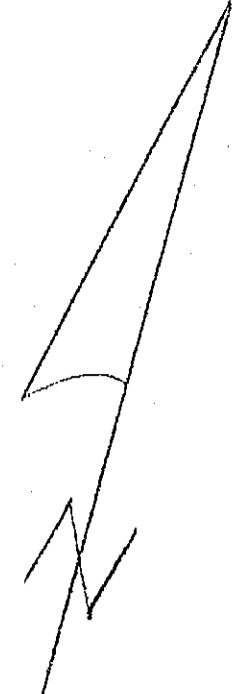
