To the Honorable Board of

Dear Members:

We the undersigned freeholders of Gallatin County, Montana, taxable herein for road purposes, do hereby petition the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Section 7-14-2601, MCA, to open a county road, being more particularly described as follows:

(1) Beginning point to open 60' wide road bears South 88 degrees 52'31" West a distance of 30' more or less from the center $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 5 East, PMM, to a point on the edge of the county road as constructed; thence South 88 degrees 52'31" West, a distance of 1,941.57 feet more or less. Total distance of county road to be opened is 1,941.57 feet.

(2) The general route of the road to be opened is shown in red on the certificate of survey attached hereto.

(3) The lands affected are shown on the certificate of survey attached hereto and are owned by Alvin and Gerald Goldenstein.

(4) Alvin and Gerald Goldenstein have been found and consent to the petition to open a county road as described above as indicated by their signatures on this petition.

(5) The necessity for and the advantage of the petitioned action as described above are as follows:

- (a) To conform with the City of Bozeman Master Plan for a road from South Third to South 19th.
- (b) To lessen the traffic flow on South Third.
- (c) To establish a more direct route for the Sourdough area to the college.
- (d) To acquire the first 1,941.57 feet, more or less, of right of way so the objectives can be accomplished.



Dear Board:

On October 3, 1985, the undersigned, being duly appointed as viewing committee, viewed and considered that portion of the property owned by Alvin and Gerald Goldenstein near the center of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 5 East, P.M.M.. that had been petitioned to open as a County Road.

The proposed 60 ft. wide road would intersect the existing So. 3rd Street where it turns South at the Center of Sec. 25, T2S, R5E, and would continue West 1972 ft, which is 3/4 th of the distance between So. 3rd Street and So. 19th Street. The particular land that would be used is level, sound and well drained. This land could be efficiently and economically improved to meet the established County un-paved highway standards. However, this will probably not be necessary, nor desirable, until such time that the remaining 1/4 distance, could be added to allow the completion of a new County Road from So. 3rd Street and So. 19th Street at the center of the West half Sec. 25, T2S, R5E.

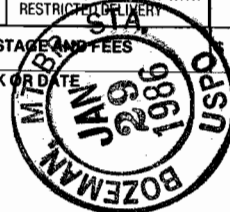

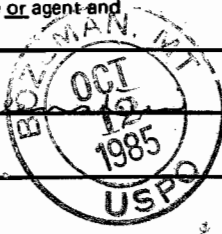

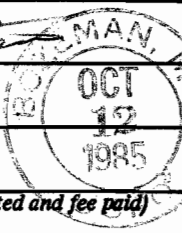
