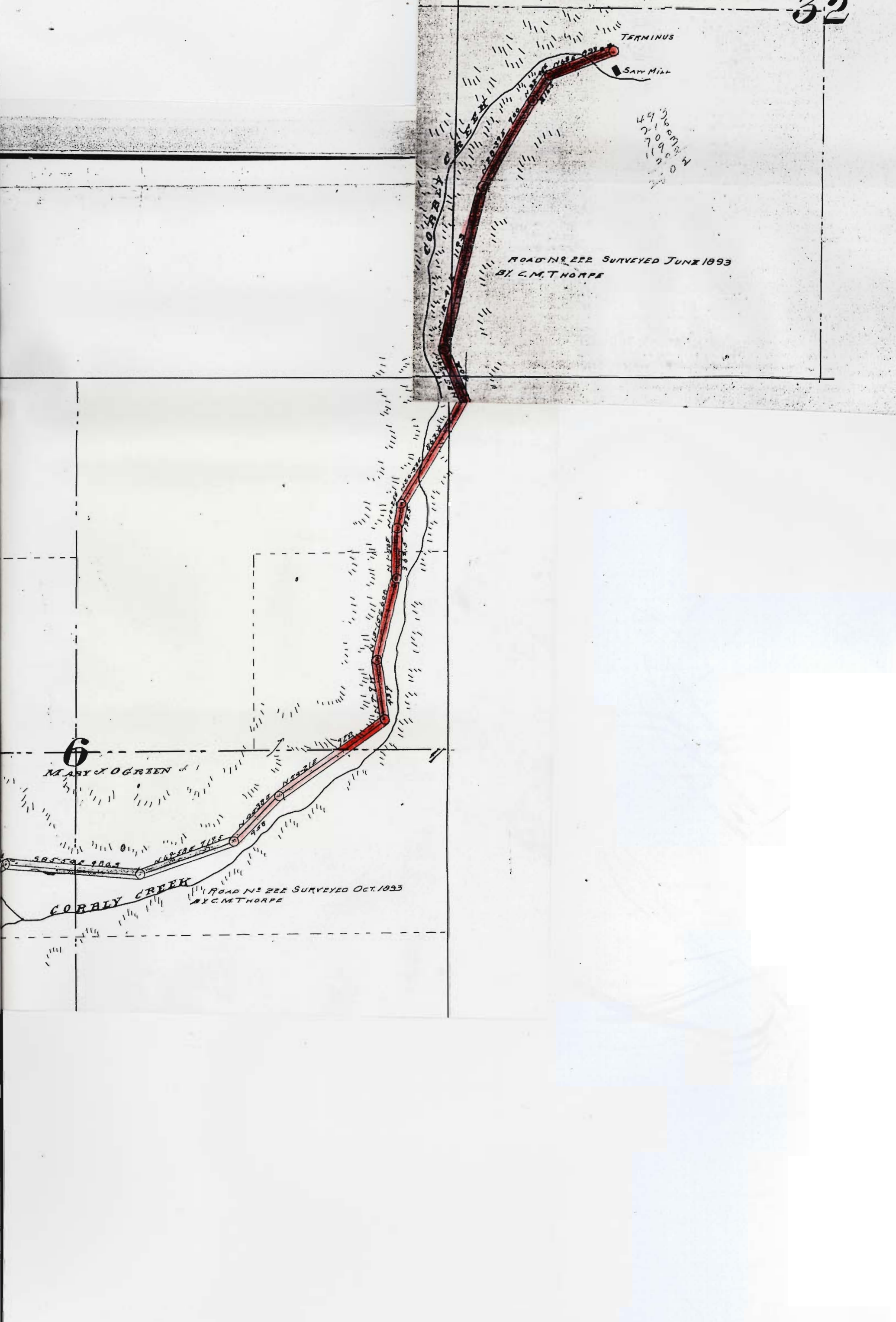

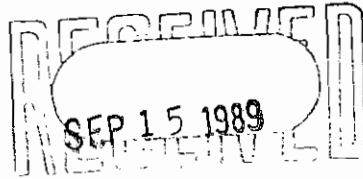

PETITION TO ABANDON A PORTION
OF CORBLY GULCH ROAD

To the Honorable Board
of County Commissioners
Gallatin County, Montana

Dear Board:

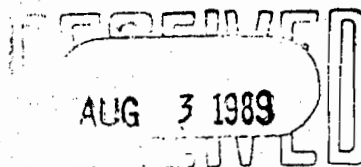
We the undersigned freeholders of Gallatin County, Montana, taxable herein for road purposes do hereby petition the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Section 7-14-2601 MCA, to abandon a portion of Corbly Gulch Road and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the East-West centerline of Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 6 East approximately 700 feet from the East quarter corner of Section 6;

Thence North 54°, 21', 400';
Thence North 7°, 9' West, 439';
Thence North 13°, 15' East, 608';
Thence North 1°, 50' East, 363.5';
Thence North 10°, 25' East, 173.5';
Thence North 30°, 33' East, 863.5';
Thence North 25°, 34° West, 402';
Thence North 12°, 41' East, 1193';
Thence North 28°, 39' East, 700';
Thence North 32°, 45' East, 216.5';
Thence North 68°, East 493' to the end of county petitioned road.

- 1 Mileage to be abandoned is 1.11 miles, more or less.
- 2 Road to be abandoned is shown in red on the attached drawing.
- 3 All land owners with land along the county road to be abandoned have signed the petition.
- 4 The portion of road to be abandoned is a dirt road inside the National forest and not maintained by the county.
- 5 To remove from county road system.
- 6 Corbly Gulch Road was established by road petition Number 222 in 1893. Reason for establishing this road was because of the sawmill at the end of the road. The sawmill doesn't exist any more.
- 7 See attached letter showing necessity and reasons for requesting abandonment by the Forest Service.

Dear Sirs:

The Bozeman District of the Gallatin National Forest is proposing to rehabilitate the road/trail in Corbly Gulch to improve the watershed. A review of the records indicates that the road/trail is designated a county road. The enclosed map indicates the road and the length of the project.

As part of the rehabilitation, the District is proposing to close the road near the Forest boundary to vehicles over forty inches wide. The road/trail would remain open to the public for all other uses. We feel this restriction is necessary to protect the road/trail from further erosion, and to allow rehabilitated areas to heal.

Because this closure affects only one type of vehicle and all remaining uses will be allowed, we do not feel there is a need for an official abandonment of the road/trail.

Enclosed for your review and approval is a Project Agreement covering this project. Upon approval, the Project Agreement should be returned to this office.

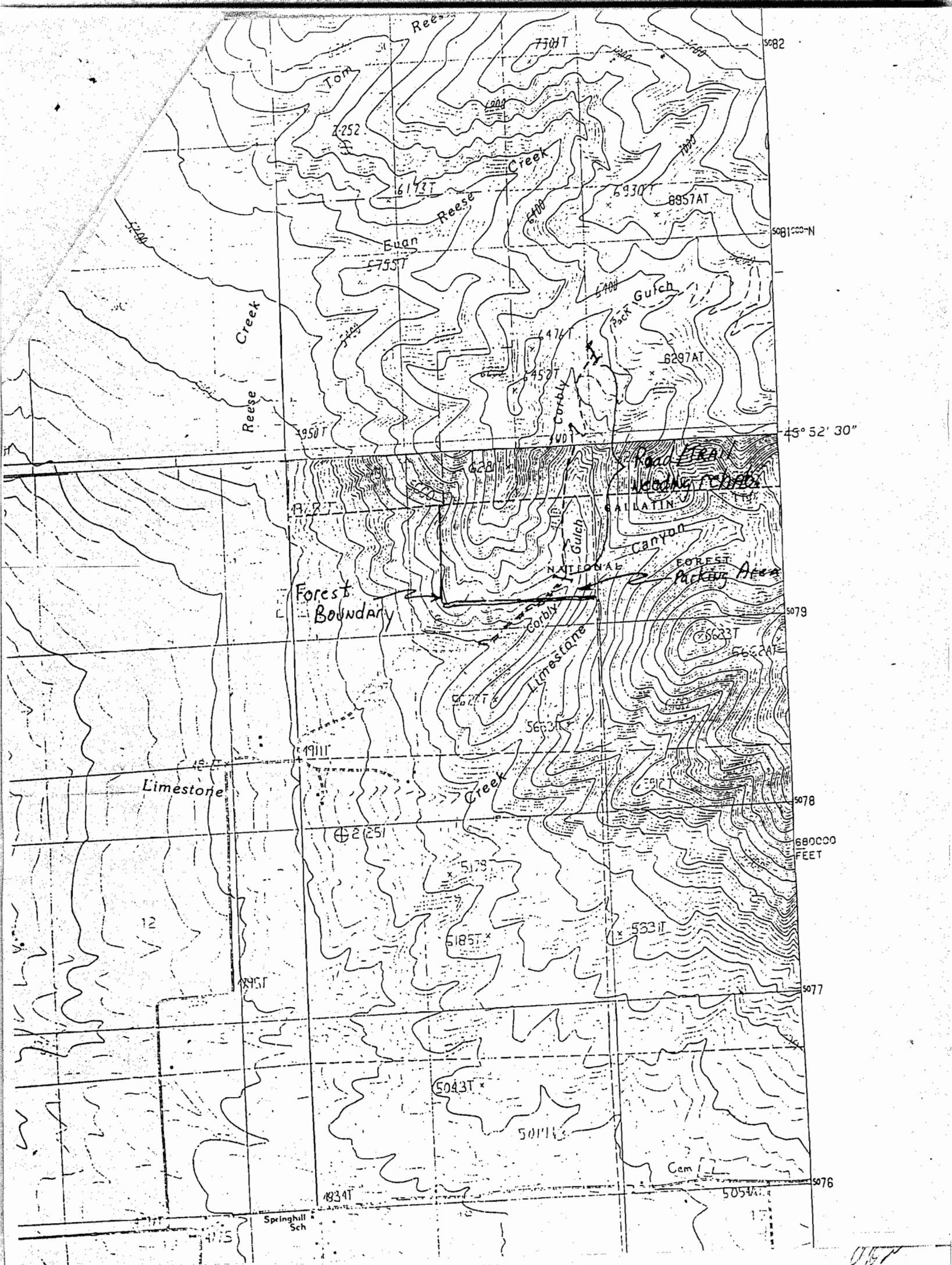

PROJECT AGREEMENT NO. 7.

Subject agreement is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, _____ by and between the County of Gallatin, hereinafter called the Cooperator, the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, hereinafter called the Forest Service and as provided for in the Forest Development Road Cooperative Agreement dated February 16, 1965.

The Forest Service intends to rehabilitate approximately one mile of the upper portion of the Corbly Gulch road located in the NE 1/4, Sec. 6, T.1N., R.5E., and in SW 1/4, Sec. 32, T.2N., R.5E. This road segment is a portion of the designated Corbly Gulch county road. The purpose of the rehabilitation is for watershed improvement.

It is understood and agreed by Gallatin County and the Forest Service, that by entering into this agreement Gallatin County is not establishing a pattern of maintaining Corbly Gulch road and is not now or in the future committing any funds to the rehabilitation of the Corbly Gulch road except as may be determined within the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners of Gallatin County. It is further understood and agreed between Gallatin County and the Forest Service, that Gallatin County enters into this agreement solely for the purpose of authorizing the Forest Service to rehabilitate as needed, those portions of the road described above, to prevent further watershed damage and to heal those areas already damaged.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed to obligate the Forest Service or Gallatin County beyond the extent of available funds allocated or programmed for this project contrary to applicable laws, rules, and regulations.

The execution of this agreement by the parties signifies their approval of the proposed project.

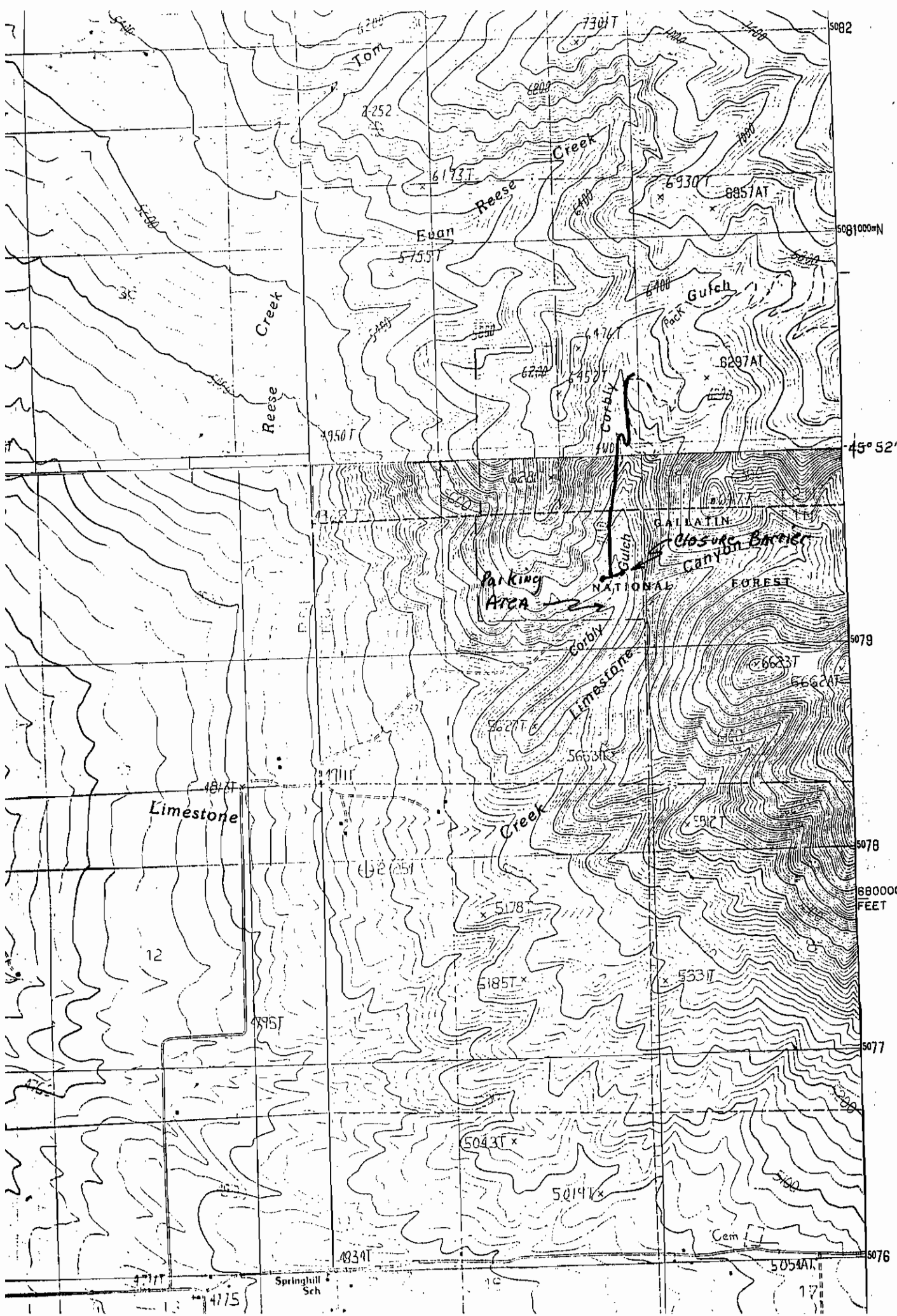

On October 11, 1989, the undersigned, being duly appointed as viewing committee, viewed a portion of Corbly Gulch Road in Section 6, T1N, R6E, and Sections 31 and 32, T2N, R6E, M.P.M., Gallatin County, Montana, which has been petitioned to be abandoned by road petition #735.

The portion of road to be abandoned is a dirt road inside National Forest property and not maintained by the County.

The viewing committee observed the washout and water erosion areas which have been created by the severe grade of the land and vehicle use on this sub-standard road.

Because the proposed abandonment still allows access to the Forest Service property, and in considering the public's health, safety, and welfare, the viewing committee recommends that portion of Corbly Gulch Road as described in road petition #735 be abandoned.




