TO: THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA


Viewers' Report

For Request To Abandon Boyd Road

April 17, 1992

The following items were observed by the Viewers' Committee:

1. The portion of road requested to be abandoned has never been built. It was platted at a time when all 10 acre parcels were required to have roads on the perimeter of all parcels.
2. If the road were built, it would access South 19th less than 700 feet north of an access already built. At the present time, the access standard for South 19th requires at least 700 feet between access points.
3. All landowners adjacent or affected by Boyd Road have signed the petition, or have stated support for the abandonment.
4. There is no public access issue.
5. Abandonment of this road will not leave any existing parcel land-locked.
6. There are sufficient roads in this area to serve existing residential properties. Whether or not any portion of this road would be necessary to serve future subdivisions, should be addressed by the County Commissioners.

and desirability of abandoning a portion of Boyd Road; and

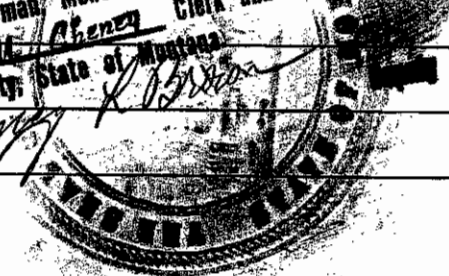
