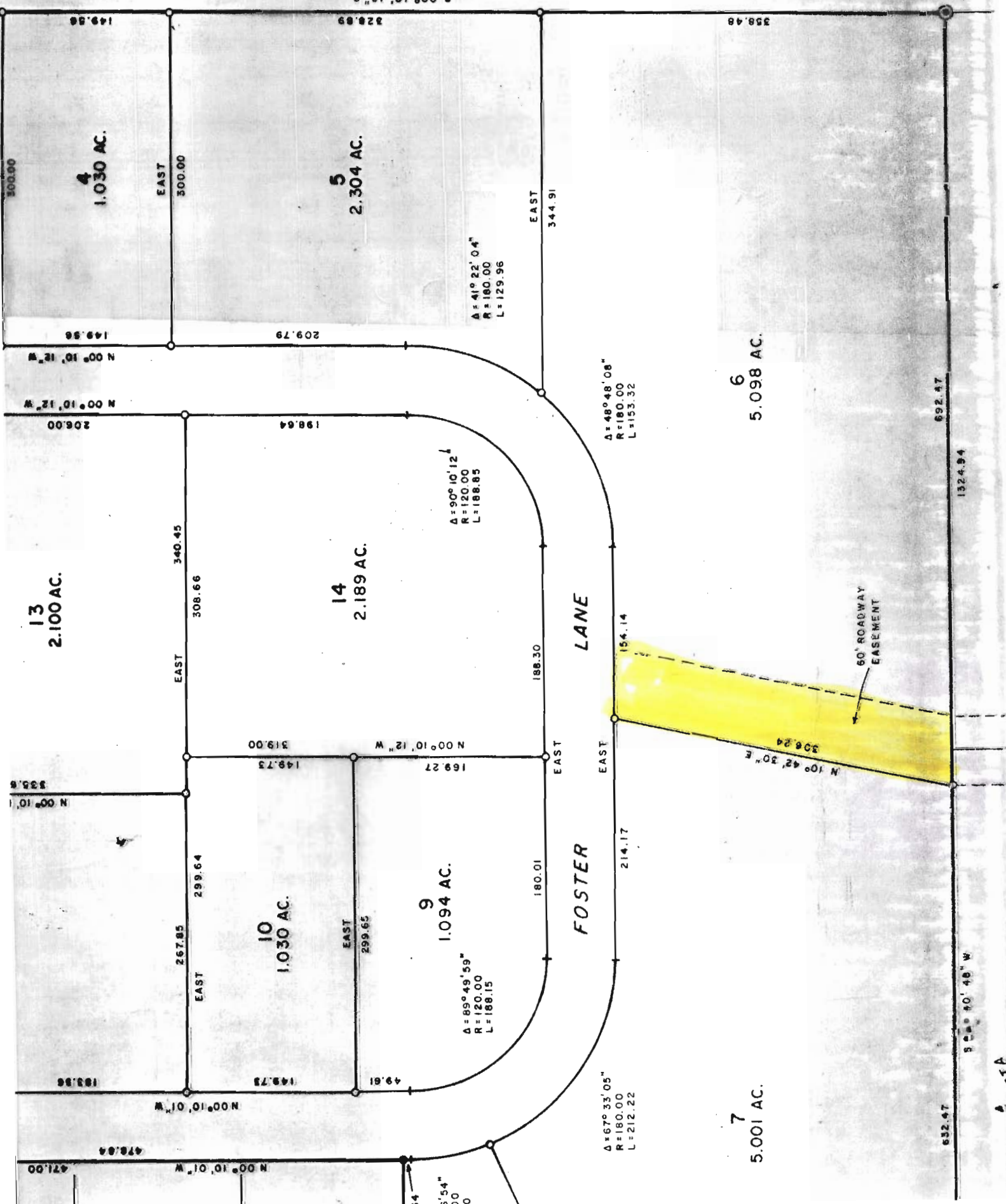



The viewing committee observed the following:

1. The road has not been built. The area in which the road should be located dips into an abandoned gravel pit approximately 10 feet deep.
2. If the road were built it would connect Foster Lane to Buena Vista Road which is a private road.
3. There would be one access into Buffalo Creek Subdivision if this road were abandoned.
4. In the event of an emergency, if the road were built, it would provide a second access.
5. Abandonment of this road would violate current county subdivision regulations.

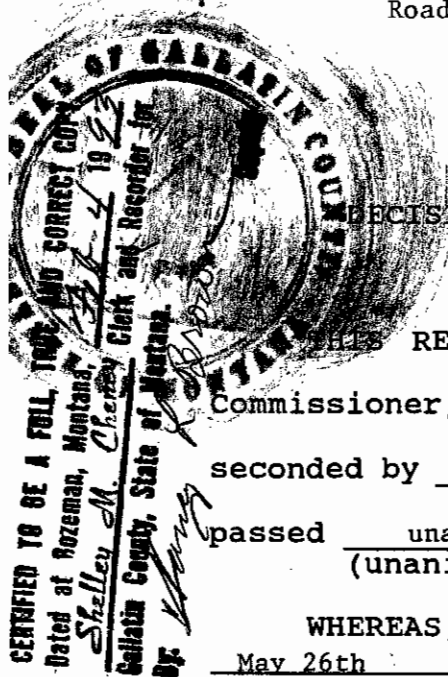
