PETITION TO ABANDON COUNTY ROAD
(APPENDIX A)

TO: THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA

COME NOW the undersigned freeholders of the road district of Gallatin County, Montana, and petition this board pursuant to Section 7-14-2601, MCA, to abandon a county road located in Gallatin County, Montana, and represent as follows:

1. The road to be abandoned is particularly described as follows:

Kanta Road begins in the NW¼ of Section 23, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, where it intersects with the Logan-Trident Road. Kanta Road then proceeds in an east-northeasterly direction through the NE¼ of Section 23, Section 14, Section 13, and Section 12 in Township 2 North, Range 2 East, and Section 7, Section 6, and Section 5 in Township 2 North, Range 3 East. The road terminates in the SW¼ of Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 3 East. A photocopy of a county map depicting the location of Kanta Road is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

The road is unsurfaced and is inaccessible with a two-wheel drive vehicle during substantial portions of the year.

2. The road is commonly known as: Kanta Road.

8. The necessity for and advantage of the abandonment of the road are as follows:


Kanta Road was created by petition at the first part of this century. The first mile of the road is in a state of severe disrepair and is not currently usable. The remainder of the road is usable with a two-wheel drive vehicle when the road is dry, but requires the use of a four-wheel drive vehicle when the road is snow-covered or wet. Kanta Road does not provide access to any inhabited dwellings. All of the private property adjacent to Kanta Road can be reached by other existing county roads.

The only public land near Kanta Road is the N½ of Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, which is owned by the United States and managed by the BLM. According to the United States Geological Survey topographical map for Logan, Montana, Kanta Road does not intersect the BLM property. The BLM has indicated in writing that it does not oppose closure of Kanta Road.

The cost of bringing Kanta Road up to county standards, and making it passable for passenger vehicles during all weather conditions could be substantial.

Because Kanta Road is not heavily utilized, does not serve public property nor private residences, and terminates on private land, there does not appear to be a strong public interest in maintaining it as a county road. Adjoining landowners would benefit from closure of Kanta Road by increasing privacy on their property and by eliminating the potential for vandalism, litter, fire, and other problems. For this reason, the undersigned landowners within Gallatin County, respectfully request that the county commissioners abandon Kanta Road.



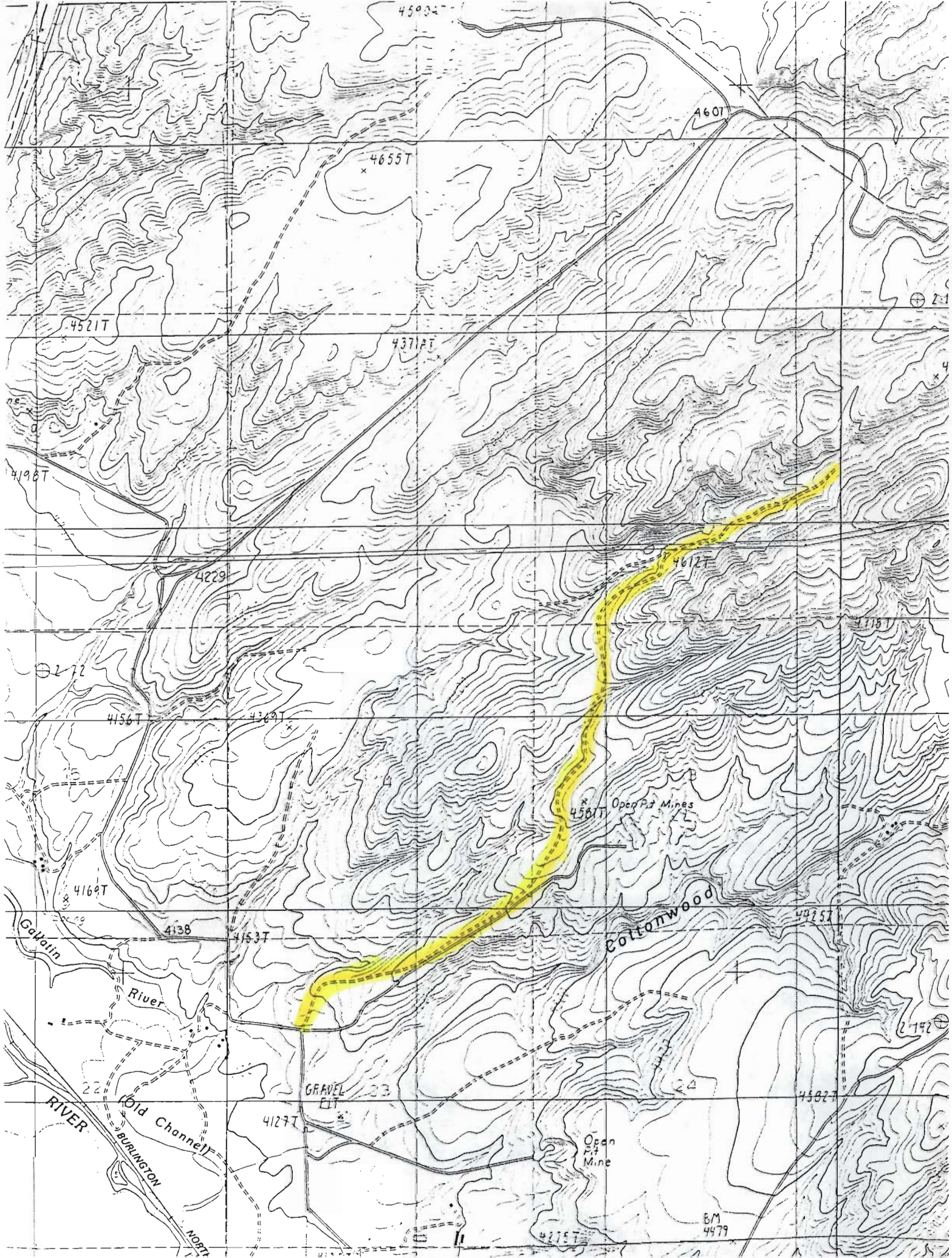

MAP OF GALLATIN COUNTY MONTANA

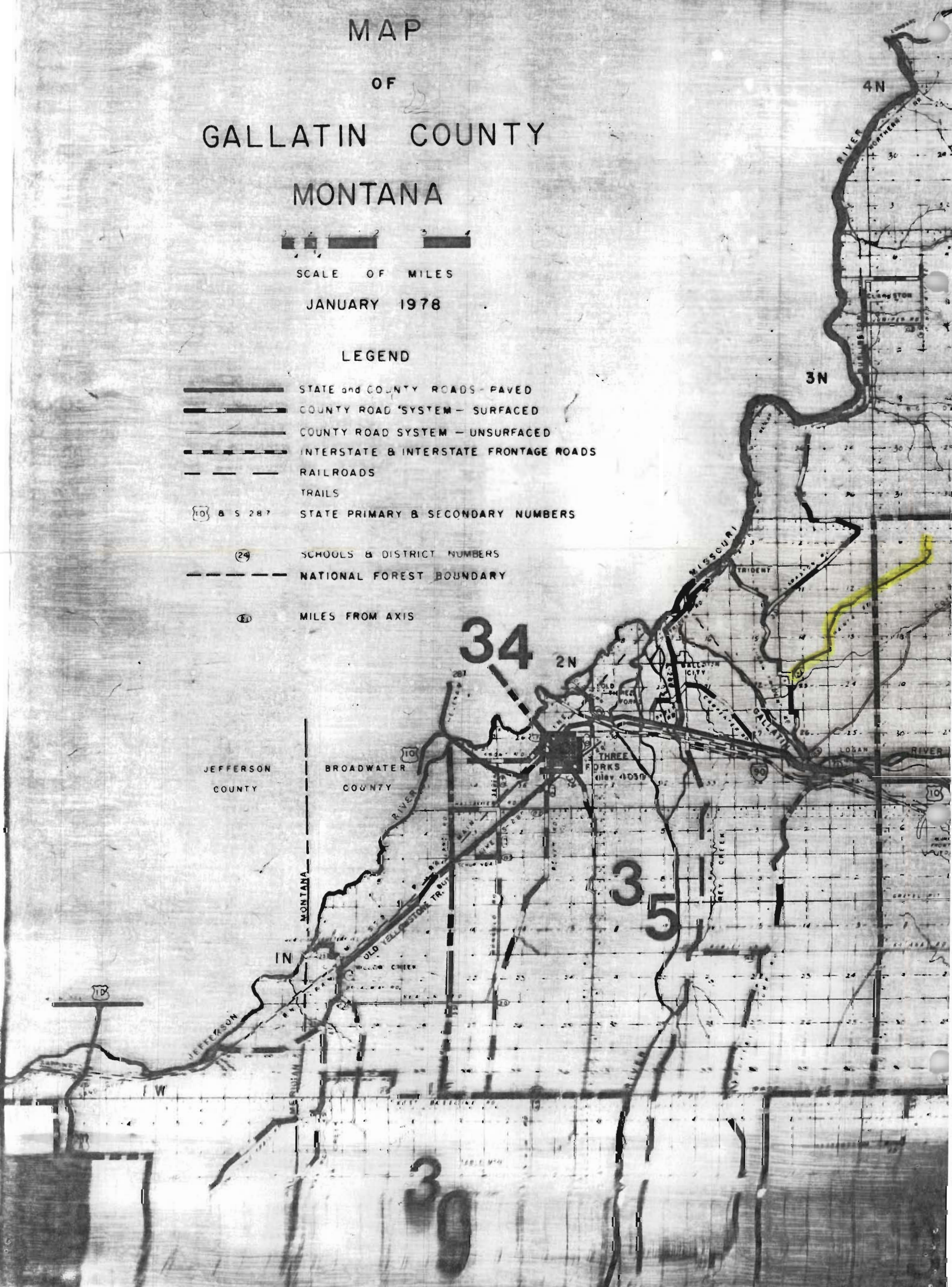

Dear Board,

On July 3, 1996, the undersigned, being appointed as viewing committee, viewed Kanta Road which is located in Sections 12, 13, 14, 23 T2N, R2E and Sections 5, 6, and 7, T2N, R3E, and being petitioned to be abandoned as described in Road Petition #778. Russ McElyea accompanied us to assist in locating the road.

The viewing committee was able to locate portions of Kanta Road. The majority of the road has not been built, and goes through hilly, rocky, grasslands.

We opened a gate and drove on a road maintained by Trident which paralleled Kanta Road for approximately 1.5 miles. We were able to distinguish where portions of Kanta Road were located many years ago. We opened another gate and drove on Kanta Road for approximately 2.5 miles. This portion of Kanta Road is being maintained by Gallatin Sporting Clays. The road appears to be 8 feet wide in spots. Certain areas of the road were sparsely graveled and contained ruts. After opening another gate we drove for approximately .5 mile. This portion of the road has not been built nor maintained. It appeared that only landowners drive this portion which contained deep ruts, sagebrush, weeds, grasses and rock. No width could be determined, only two tracks for a path. At this point we reached another gate and viewed that the remainder of the road (approximately 1.5 miles) was in the same condition as the last .5 mile.

During our review Sam Gianfrancisco stated that his research concluded that the centerline of Kanta Road was surveyed in 1916 and became a road by use. We assume that the road we viewed and the road surveyed are one in the same. County records indicated that this road has not been maintained for at least the last 33 years. He also provided us with a letter from BLM confirming no objection to the abandonment and a copy of an agreement between Ashcraft, Green, and Gallatin Sporting Clays regarding access and the abandonment.

It does not appear that any landowner would become land locked, nor anyone denied access to public lands if this petition were granted. The N1/2 of Section 12, T2N, R2E, which is owned by BLM can be accessed from Clarkston Road.



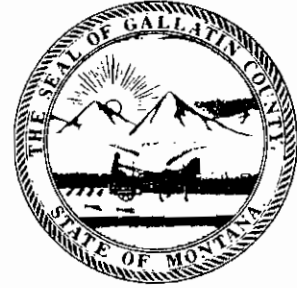

RESOLUTION NO. 1996 - 40

**DECISION CONCERNING PETITION TO ABANDON COUNTY ROAD,
KANTA ROAD**

WHEREAS, a Petition to Abandon County Road was filed requesting to abandon Kanta road described as:

Beginning in the NW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, where it intersects with the Logan Trident Road. Kanta Road then proceeds in an east-northeasterly direction through the NE 1/4 of Section 23, Section 14, Section 13, and Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, and Section 7, Section 6 and Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 3 East. The road terminates in the SW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 3 East.

WHEREAS, on April 6, 1996, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder reported to the Gallatin County Commissioners that the petition contained sufficient signatures as required by Section 7-14-2601, MCA; and

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners appointed a committee consisting of one county commissioner, the county surveyor and the road supervisor to investigate the feasibility and desirability of abandoning the road; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 1996, the Gallatin County Commissioners conducted a public hearing, after notice on the petition and the results of the investigation.

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the petition and abandon Kanta Road as described above.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Based on the petition, results of the investigation and information presented at the public hearing on July 23, 1996, the Gallatin County Commissioners conclude that the decision made herein is in the best interests of the county,

2. The following road as requested in the Petition to Abandon County Road is abandoned:

Kanta road described as:

Beginning in the NW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, where it intersects with the Logan Trident Road. Kanta Road then proceeds in an east-

northeasterly direction through the NE 1/4 of Section 23, Section 14, Section 13, and Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, and Section 7, Section 6 and Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 3 East. The road terminates in the SW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 3 East.

3. Within ten (10) days from the date that this resolution is adopted the Clerk and Recorder shall send a copy of this resolution by certified mail to all owners of land abutting on the road. The owners shall be those listed on the last county assessment roll.

4. The Clerk and Recorder shall notify the county road supervisor by furnishing a certified copy of this resolution to the supervisor.

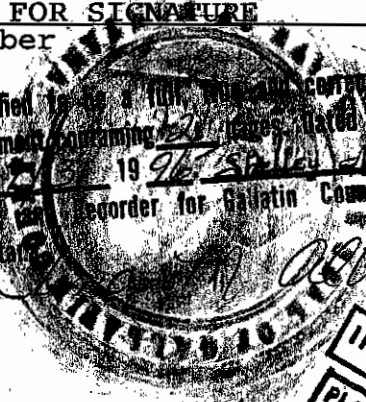




