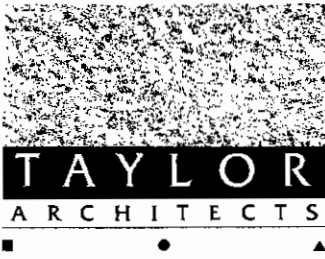

TO: THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA

COME NOW the undersigned freeholders of the road district of Gallatin County, Montana, and petition this board pursuant to Section 7-14-2601, MCA, to abandon a county road located in Gallatin County, Montana and represent as follows:

1. The road to be abandoned is particularly described as follows: The county road originally known as Vigilante Trail Court, but now known as Orville Way. Road is planned as a cul-de-sac but said cul-de-sac does not yet exist. The road is 444.19' long. The cul-de-sac is planned for the west end of the road. We request that only the cul-de-sac (100' diameter) be abandoned.







The necessity for and advantage of the abandonment of the road are as follows: Abandonment will facilitate improved access to increased parking facilities for Gibson Guitar by allowing us to expand our parking lot to meet the standards set by the county and city. Expanded parking will be necessary upon completion of our proposed building expansion. It will also allow us to meet the necessary landscaping improvements as recommended by the Bozeman City-County Planning Commission.

The abandonment will also allow for a more direct turn around for emergency equipment. The attached site plan indicates the proposed turn around. This proposal will be presented to the various affected fire departments for their review. Those approvals will be submitted to the Clerk and Recorder's Office and County Road Supervisor as soon as they are finalized.

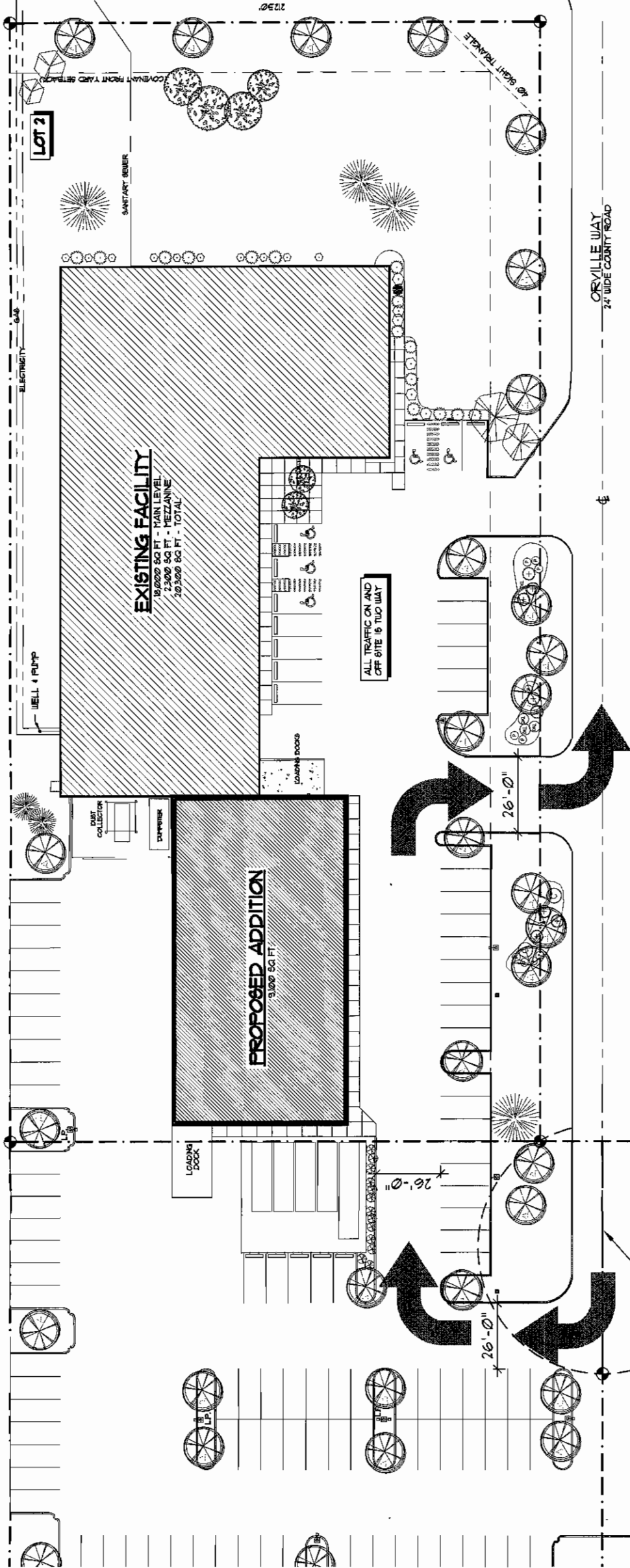

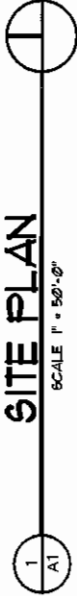

The public hearing on the above-referenced petition is scheduled for tomorrow, January 14. The Viewing Committee assigned to this petition has recommended that you receive comments from emergency services prior to considering approval of abandonment. I have taken the liberty of contacting the Bozeman Fire Department, MedTrans of Montana (ambulance), the Gallatin County Sheriff's Department, the Rae Fire Department, and the Bozeman Police Department. I have attached written comments indicating approval from the first four. The Bozeman Police Department indicated that this property is located outside of their jurisdiction and so they would have no comment or concern.

We had planned for this process to be completed long before the project came up before the City of Bozeman for approval. Unfortunately, it all seems to be happening at once. In addition to the public hearing on this petition, we have public hearings before Bozeman's Development Review Committee and Design Review Board on Tuesday. The Planning Office has indicated that without your approval of this petition, that process may be pushed back by as much as another month. 
Dear Mr. Milleson:

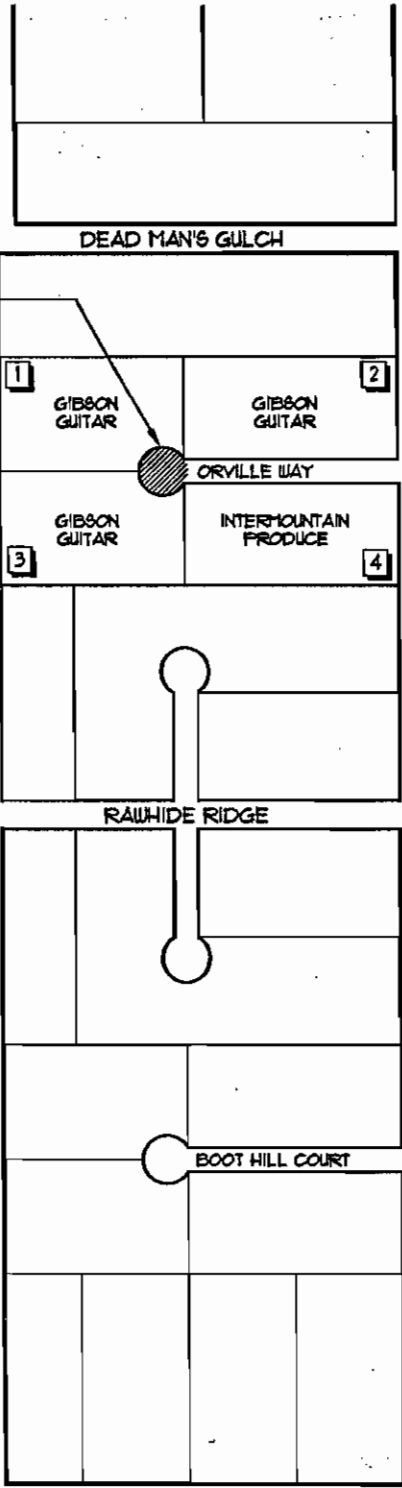

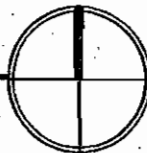

VICINITY MAP

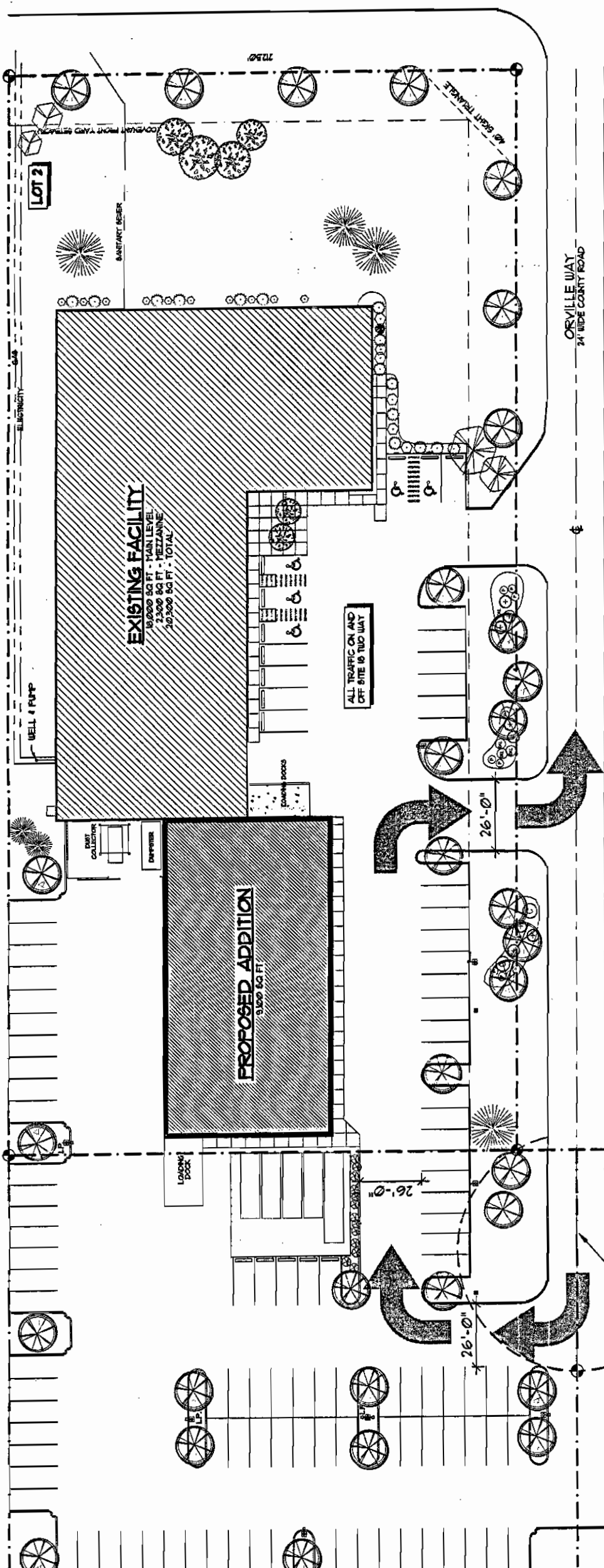

On December 12, 1996, the undersigned, being appointed as viewing committee, viewed the a 100' diameter cul-de-sac at the end of Orville Way in Gardner-Simmental Plaza Subdivision which is being petitioned to be abandoned as described in Road Petition #780. This subdivision is located between Interstate 90, North 19th, and south of Baxter Lane.

The petitioners desire to abandon the cul-de-sac in order to increase parking facilities and meet landscaping improvements recommended by the Bozeman City-County Planning Commission. Gibson Guitar, the owner of all the affected parcels, is proposing to expand their building.

It does not appear that any landowner would become land locked, nor anyone denied access to public lands if this petition were granted. The State Department of Transportation has limited the access to North 19th. If Orville Way were ever constructed to the west, access onto North 19th would not be allowed.

The viewing committee is concerned whether or not emergency services would have enough room to provide their services if the petition were granted. We suggest the Commission receive comments from emergency services prior to considering the abandonment.

RESOLUTION NO. 1997- 7DECISION CONCERNING PETITION TO ABANDON A PORTION OF ROADWAY
ORVILLE WAY, LOCATED GARDNER-SIMMENTAL PLAZA SUBDIVISION
AND
FINDINGS OF FACT REGARDING VACATING A PORTION OF THE PLAT

WHEREAS, a Petition to Abandon County Road was filed on November 19, 1996, requesting that the cul de sac portion of Orville Way located in Gardner-Simmental Plaza Subdivision be abandoned; and

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder reported to the Gallatin County Commissioners on December 3, 1996, that the petition contained sufficient signatures as required by Section 7-14-2601, MCA; and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 1996, the Gallatin County Commissioners appointed a viewing committee consisting of one county commissioner, the county surveyor and road supervisor to investigate the feasibility and desirability of abandoning the road; and

WHEREAS, on January 14, 1997, the Gallatin County Commissioners conducted a public hearing, after notice, on the petition and the results of the investigation; and

WHEREAS, Section 76-3-305, MCA states that;

Any plat prepared and recorded as provided in this section maybe be vacated in whole or in part as provided by7-14-2616(1) and (2). Upon vacation, the governing body ... shall determine to which properties the title to the streets and alleys of the vacated portions must revert. The governing body shall take into consideration the previous platting; the manner in which the right-of-way was originally dedicated, granted or conveyed; the reasons stated in the petition requesting the vacation; the parties requesting the vacation; and any agreements between the adjacent property owners regarding the use of the vacated area; and

WHEREAS, the Orville Way was platted as part of the Gardner-Simmental Plaza Subdivision, which was filed January 9, 1975; and

WHEREAS, Orville Way was dedicated to the public use; and

WHEREAS, no reason remains for cul de sac portion of Orville Way since the lots served by the cul de sac are under single ownership and emergency services have no objection to the abandonment; and

WHEREAS, the single owner will acquire the cul de sac to be included as part of parking and emergency travel access.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Based on the petition, results of the investigation and information presented at the public hearing the Gallatin County Commissioners conclude that the decision made herein is in the best interests of the county and feasible and desirable for the use and benefit of the public and does not land lock any other land or deny access to public lands.

2. As requested in the Petition to Abandon County Road, the Cul de Sac portion of Orville Way, located in of Gardner-Simmental Plaza Subdivision is abandoned.

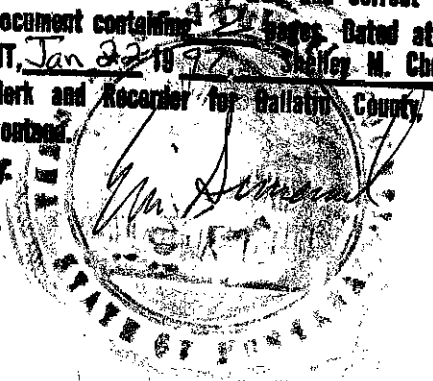
3. The title of the vacated land shall revert to the land owner of the property surrounding the cul de sac.

3. Within ten (10) days from the date that this resolution is adopted the Clerk and Recorder shall send a copy of this resolution by certified mail to all owners of land abutting on the road. The owners shall be those listed on the last county assessment roll.

4. The Clerk and Recorder shall notify the county road supervisor by furnishing a certified copy of this resolution to the supervisor.
