DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY TO BE ABANDONED

A portion of an undeveloped road easement granted by Hammersmark Ranch Co., a corporation, to Gallatin County, Montana dated February 9, 1987, recorded February 10, 1987 in Film 95, page 4557, records of Gallatin County, Montana. The easement is located in Section 5, Township 1 North, Range 7 East, P.M.M. The easement was obtained in connection with a proposed project with the Montana Department of Transportation to modify the Bracket Creek Road in that section. The project contemplated building one bridge in Section 5 to replace two bridges - one owned by the State and one by the County. Subsequent to the granting of the easement both the State and the County have replaced both bridges with new ones and the project has been abandoned.

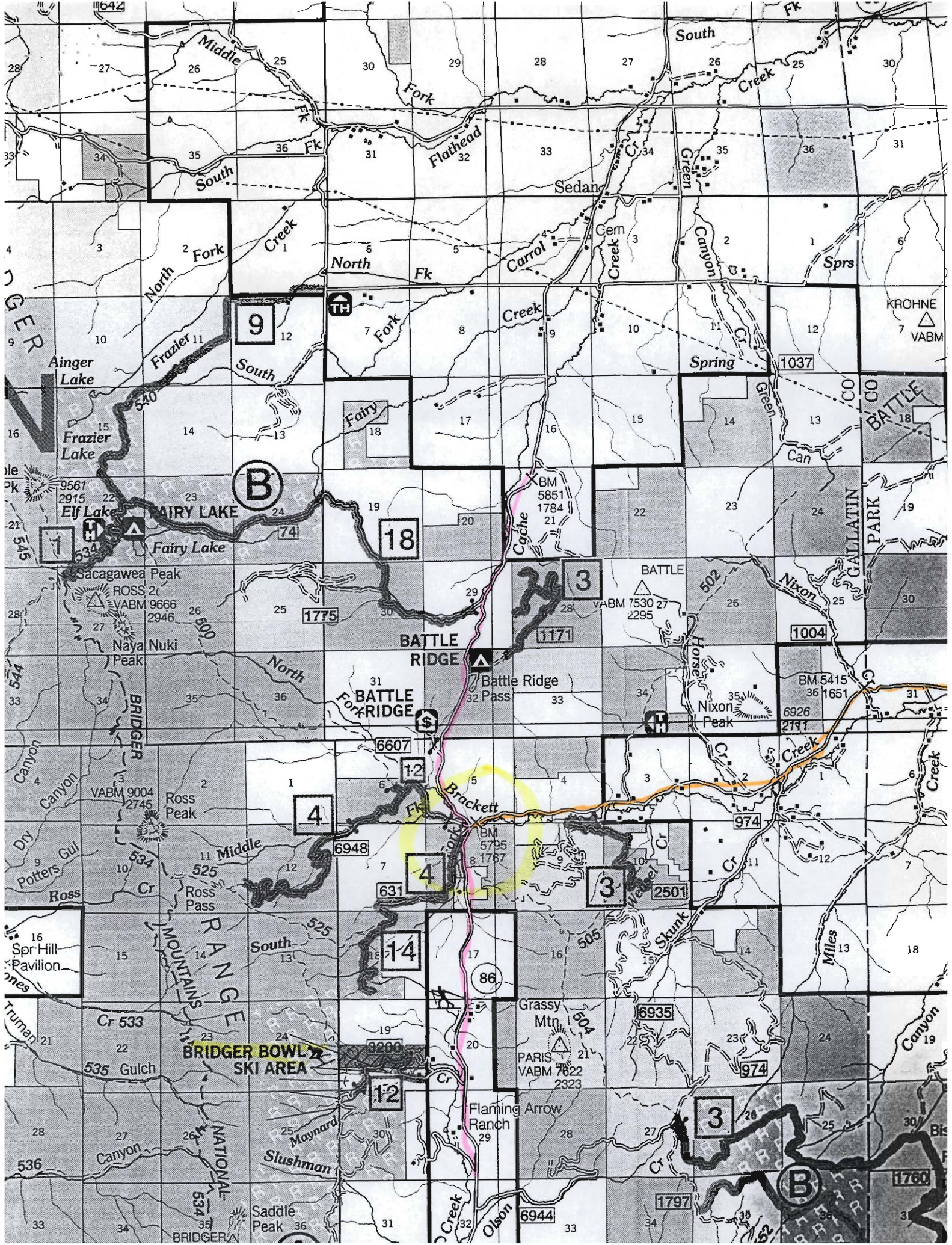
This request is for Gallatin County to abandon all portions of the easement not actually within the right-of-way of the Bracket Creek Road as currently constructed.

Exception #18 (Section 5 -T1N/R7E)



Easement (95-4557).

The geographic description in this easement appears to be inaccurate. The Brackett Creek Road begins at a junction with State Highway 86 in the northern portion of section 8, T01N, R07E. The road angles in a northeast direction through section 5. The total length of this road in section 5, calculated by the GIS using the location provided by Gallatin County derived from GPS, was approximately 2,800 feet. The length of the easement described in the exhibit with Exception 18 is 1,041 feet. The origin, or point of beginning, does not match the two plats received from the Montana Department of Transportation, nor any existing road features. There is no indication that a surveyor prepared this document and it appears to be in error. With the documents provided it is not possible to identify exactly where this easement begins. It is drawn on this exhibit exactly in the position described in the text. The centerline and easements were prepared using coordinate geometry in Autocad by Land and Water Consulting, The Bureau of Land Management GCDB quarter corner was used as the source to begin the COGO. Appendix B is attached.



Dear Board,

On February 20, 1998, the undersigned, being appointed as viewing committee, viewed the area described above which has been petitioned to be abandoned as described in Road Petition #784.

We observed the location of the easement from the west while on Bridger Canyon Road, (State Highway 86) and from the east while on Brackett Creek Road. The easement has not been constructed.

According to the petition, this easement was granted to assist in completing projects planned by the Montana Department of Transportation and Gallatin County in 1987. Since that time both the state and county have replaced bridges and the original project has been abandoned.

It does not appear that anyone would become land-locked nor access denied to public lands if the abandonment were granted.

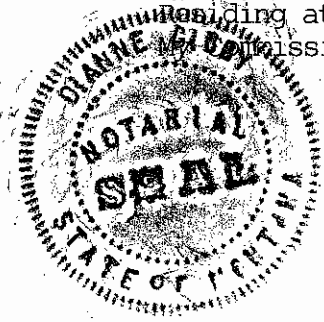

A RESOLUTION DISCLAIMING INTEREST IN
GOVERNMENT LAND OFFICE ROAD EASEMENTS IN

WHEREAS, the 1908-1909 Government Land Office (GLO) map in Section 5, Township 1 North, Range 7 East, Gallatin County, Montana, P.M.M. shows three (3) roads, two of which run in the general direction of the existing Bridger Canyon Road, also known as State Highway 86, and one of which runs in the general direction of the existing Brackett Creek Road, which roads are shown on Exhibit A in the black bold lines and marked "GLO Roads" for further clarity; and

WHEREAS, a review of the Gallatin County Road records shows that the road easements appearing on the GLO map are not now and have not for many years been used as roads; and

WHEREAS, said road easements were not established under applicable Montana law prior to the withdrawal of said Section from the public domain.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Gallatin County Commission disclaims any interest in these three (3) road easements shown on the 1908-1909 GLO map in Section 5, Township 1 North, Range 7 East, P.M.M., in Gallatin County, Montana, depicted in black bold lines and marked "GLO Roads" on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

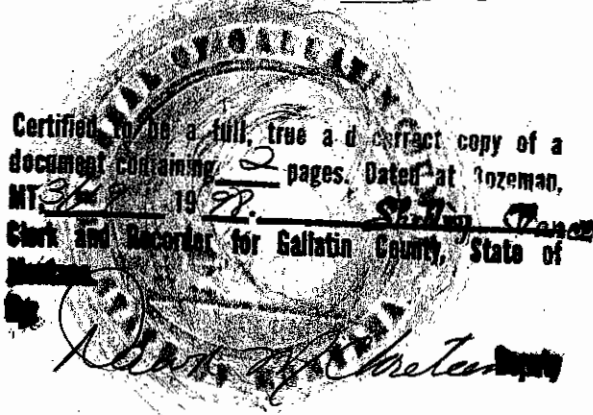

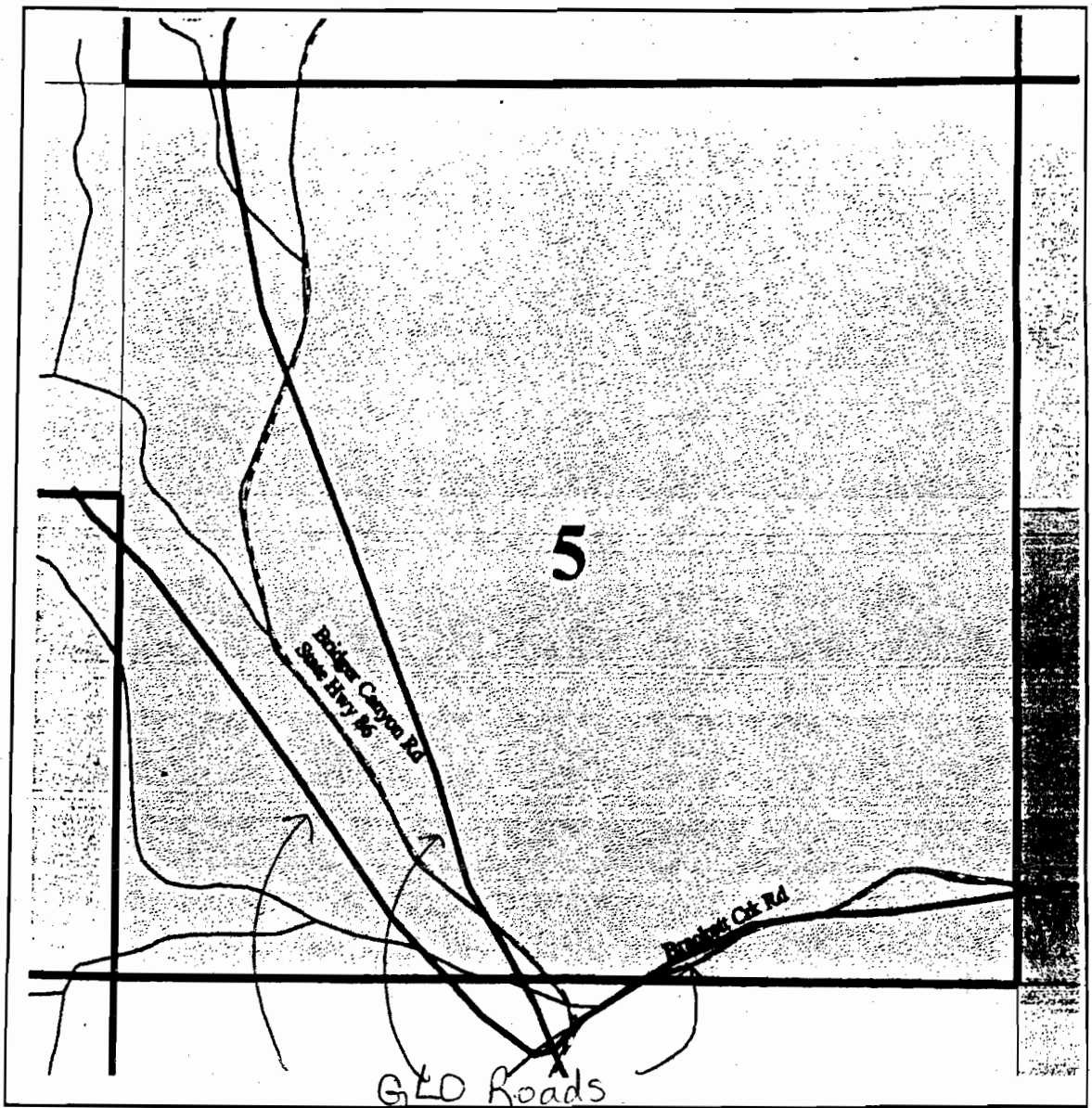

GLO roads mapped Aug 1, 1908 - Sept. 23, 1909. The GLO roads mapped here are superimposed on existing road locations mapped by Gallatin County using GPS. Differences in the mapped location could possibly be a result of relocation of the road over time. Though we can only speculate, it is more likely the difference results from different map sources and scales.

The historic maps appear to be more generalized, and there was no information on the mapping methods they used.

Phone conversation with Nancy Halstrom, Bozeman Ranger District, USFS 12/9/97 indicated that she believed State Highway 86 had not been relocated since the easement was granted in 1956. She had no additional GLO information and stated that the courthouse record was the best record available.

**DECISION CONCERNING PETITION TO ABANDON COUNTY ROAD,
AN EASEMENT TO MODIFY THE BRACKET CREEK ROAD**

WHEREAS, a Petition to Abandon County Road was filed requesting to abandon a road easement described on Film 95, Page 4557 of records of the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder which is located in the S 1/2 of Section 5, T1N, R7E, Gallatin County, Montana. The easement is located north of the intersection of Bridger Canyon Road (State Highway 86) and Brackett Creek Road.

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder reported to the Gallatin County Commissioners that the petition contained sufficient signatures as required by Section 7-14-2601, MCA; and

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners appointed a committee consisting of one county commissioner, the county surveyor and the road supervisor to investigate the feasibility and desirability of abandoning the road; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1998, the Gallatin County Commissioners conducted a public hearing, after notice on the petition and the results of the investigation.

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the petition and abandon that portion of the road easement described in Film 95, Page 4557 of the records of the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder which is located in the S 1/2 of Section 5, T1N, R7E, Gallatin County, Montana.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Based on the petition, results of the investigation and information presented at the public hearing on March 10, 1998, the Gallatin County Commissioners conclude that the decision made herein is in the best interests of the county.

2. The following road as requested in the Petition to Abandon County Road is abandoned:

That portion of the road easement described in Film 95, Page 4557 of the records of the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder which is located in the S 1/2 of Section 5, T1N, R7E, Gallatin County, Montana.

3. Within ten (10) days from the date that this resolution is adopted the Clerk and Recorder shall send a copy of this resolution by certified mail to all owners of land abutting on the road. The owners shall be those listed on the last county assessment roll.

4. The Clerk and Recorder shall notify the county road supervisor by furnishing a certified copy of this resolution to the supervisor.
