

COME NOW the undersigned freeholders of the road district of Gallatin County, Montana, and petition this board pursuant to Section 7-14-2601, MCA, to abandon a county road located in Gallatin County, Montana and represent as follows:

1. The road to be ESTABLISHED is particularly described as follows: Beginning at the corner of Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, thence N87°59'55"E 265.73 feet and S09°18'04"W 24.45 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence S19°03'00"W 766.95 feet to a point on the centerline of the original location of Pine Butte Road at the southerly terminus of the proposed abandonment of a portion of Pine Butte Road, T2S, R4E, PMM, as shown on attached EXHIBIT.

I apologize for failing to complete the question on the document referring to the "necessity for and advantage of the abandonment and reestablishment of road easement." I request this easement be moved for the following reasons:

1. I hope to sell my farm house and buildings with acreage this calendar year. I believe the house will be more appealing to prospective buyers if this easement and the deeded right of way belonging to Alberda Angus Ranch were not so close to the house.
2. The proposed location will provide a shorter, more direct route for Alberdas to move cattle to and from their pasture.

Dear Board,

The undersigned, being appointed as viewing committee, viewed the area described to be established in Road Petition #789 on February 16, 1999.

Starting at the intersection of Norris Road and Pine Butte Road we traveled in a southerly direction to the end of the constructed Pine Butte Road. The end on the constructed Pine Butte Road is at approximately the east/west section line between Sections 16 and 21, T2S, R4E. At the end of this road is a constructed driveway that accesses a home located in the NE1/4 of Section 20, T2S, R4E.

If the Commission determines that Pine Butte Road Petition #158 was never established the following are presented for consideration:

1. Starting at the intersection of Norris Road, Pine Butte Road runs southerly for approximately 1 1/2 miles as a road by use.
2. If the Commission accepts this petition to establish a road there will be approximately 767 feet established as a petitioned county road on the southern end of a road by use which will end in the middle of a field. This road will not provide access to any public lands or any other roads in close proximity.
3. If the Commission establishes this road, they are required to find the amount of damages (right-of-way purchase) sustained by each owner or claimant of land affected by the road.
4. It does not appear that the establishment of this road will benefit the general public.

DECISION CONCERNING PETITION TO ESTABLISH A PORTION OF PINE BUTTE ROAD

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1999, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder presented to the Gallatin County Commission a Petition to Re-Establish that portion of Pine Butte Road described as follows:

An easement sixty feet in width located in the Northeast One-Quarter of Section 20 and the Northwest One-Quarter of Section 21, Township 2 South, Range 4 East, P.M.M., being thirty feet in width on each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the common corner of Section 16, 17, 20 and 21, thence along the line between said Sections 16 and 21 North 87 degrees, 59 minutes, 55 seconds East 265.73 feet to a point of the centerline of Pine Butte Road, and along said center line South 09 degrees, 18 minutes, 04 seconds West 74.45 feet to an angle in said centerline at the true point of beginning, thence through the lands of Noyes in part and in part through the lands of J Open A Ranch South 19 degrees, 03 minutes, 00 seconds West 766.95 feet to a point on the center line of the original location of Pine Butte Road, said point being on the line between said Sections 20 and 21, said point being at the southerly terminus of the proposed abandonment of a portion of said Pine Butte Road and said point being located North 22 degrees, 13 minutes, 58 seconds West 1858 feet from the Southwest corner of the Northwest One-Quarter of said Section 21 in Gallatin County, Montana; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1999, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder reported to the Gallatin County Commissioners that the petition contained sufficient signatures as required by Section 7-14-2601, MCA; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1999, the Gallatin County Commissioners appointed a viewing committee consisting of one county commissioner, the county surveyor and the road superintendent to investigate the feasibility and desirability of abandoning the road, and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 1999, the appointed viewing committee submitted their report to Gallatin County Commissioners. Thereafter the Gallatin County Commissioners conducted a public hearing, after notice, on the petition and the results of the investigation; and

WHEREAS, in the agenda item considered prior to this Petition for Re-Establishment [Creation], the Gallatin County Commission reviewed the history of Pine Butte Road as described in Petition 158. The Gallatin County Commission determined that Petition 158 petitioning the establishment of Pine Butte Road was submitted to the Gallatin County Commission in March of 1900. On June 6, 1900, the Gallatin County Commission

conducted a hearing to accept public testimony regarding the creation of Pine Butte Road as petitioned for in Petition 158. On June 6, 1900, the Gallatin County Commission deferred action until some future date. A thorough search of the records of the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder and the Gallatin County Road Department revealed that the Gallatin County Commission never took any action regarding Petition 158 establishing Pine Butte Road; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 1999, the Gallatin County Commission further determined that Pine Butte Road as described in Petition 158 was never established and voted unanimously to not establish Pine Butte as petitioned for in Petition 158; and

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commission having determined that Pine Butte Road as described in Petition 158 was not established, considering the viewing committee report and the location of the proposed road, determined that it was not in the best interest of the public to establish the portion of Pine Butte Road as describe in the Petition for Re-Establishment [Creation].

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Gallatin County Commission determines it is not in best interest of Gallatin County to establish Pine Butte Road as described in the Petition for Re-Establishment.

2. Within ten (10) days from the date a Resolution of Abandonment is adopted and the Clerk and Recorder shall send a copy of that resolution by certified mail to all owners of land abutting on the road. The owners shall be those listed on the last county assessment roll.

3. The Clerk and Recorder shall notify the county road supervisor by furnishing a certified copy of this resolution to the supervisor.
