

Dear Board,

The undersigned, being appointed as viewing committee, viewed the area to be abandoned by Road Petition #798. Gallatin County Road Superintendent Lee Provance accompanied the viewing committee as a consultant.

According to 7-14-2603 M.C.A., the Board of County Commissioners shall cause an investigation to be made of the feasibility, desirability, and cost of granting the prayer of the petition. The investigation shall be sufficient to properly determine the merits or demerits of the petition.

According to the petition submitted, the necessity for and advantage of the abandonment is two fold: 1) An approach permit is not available on Valley Center Road, and 2) The adjacent landowners desire to use the extension of North 27th Street which would be in accordance with the Bozeman Master Plan.

The viewing committee traveled westerly along Valley Center Road and located wooden stakes set by Surveyor Tom Henesh along the northern portion of Roxi Lane where it would intersect with Valley Center Road. Roxi Lane has not been constructed. This potential intersection is very close to a sharp curve on Valley Center Road, and if constructed, would create severe safety issues related to site distances. We continued westerly to the intersection of North 27th Street and Valley Center Road turning onto North 27th Street. The construction of both Roxi Lane and North 27th Street is unnecessary, and would have a negative effect on the usability of lots located within Minor Subdivision 221.

No one would become land locked, nor denied access to public lands if the petition were granted.

It is feasible to abandon Roxi Lane because the road has not been constructed, and access using the extension of North 27th Street is more desirable for safety issues.

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 49

CONCERNING DECISION TO ABANDON A PARCEL OF LAND RUNNING
ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF MINOR SUBDIVISION 221 AND NOW COMMONLY
KNOWN AS ROXI LANE

This Resolution was introduced by Clerk and Recorder Shelley Vanca; moved by Commissioner Vincent and seconded by Commissioner Mitchell. This Resolution was adopted unanimously.

Commissioner Murdock was absent.

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2000, the Clerk and Recorder received a petition to abandon a county road, more particularly described as a parcel of land being the road shown running along the east side of Minor Subdivision No. 221 and now known as Roxi Lane; and,

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2000, the Clerk and Recorder presented the Petition to Abandon to the Gallatin County Commissioners and certified that the petition contained sufficient signatures as required by Section 7-14-2601, MCA; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2000, the Gallatin County Commissioners appointed a viewing committee consisting of one county commissioner and the county surveyor; and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2001, the viewing committee reported: the road is not constructed and no one would become landlocked, nor denied access to public lands if the petition were granted; an approach permit is not available on Valley Center Road; the adjacent landowners desire to use the extension of North 27th Street which would be in accordance with the Bozeman Master Plan; the northern portion of Roxi Lane would potentially intersect very close to a sharp curve on Valley Center Road, and if constructed would create severe safety issues related to site distances; and, the construction of both Roxi Lane and North 27th Street is unnecessary, and would have a negative effect on the usability of lots located within Minor Subdivision 221; and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2001, the Gallatin County Commissioners conducted a public hearing, after notice, on the petition and the results of the investigation; continued their decision until March 20, 2001; further continued their decision until April 3, 2001; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2001 the Gallatin County Commissioners found that the best interests of the county would be served by granting the petition and abandoning a parcel of land being the road shown running along the east side of Minor Subdivision No. 221 and now known as Roxi Lane in Gallatin County, Montana.

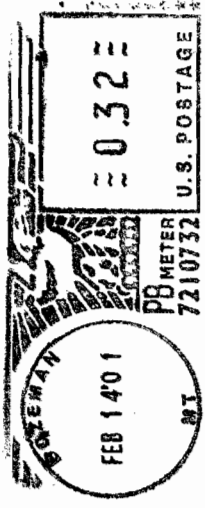

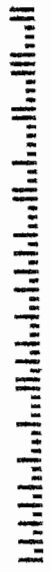
