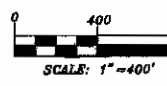

#8 Necessity for and advantage of abandonment:

On the east boundary of Section 24 T3N R7E Gallatin County and the west boundary of Section 19 3N 8E Park County, a road petitioned as # 432 was viewed and surveyed prior to Oct. 4, 1924. There is no other evidence that a legitimate road was ever placed on the land. No historical nor physical evidence can be found that a actual road was ever put in place on that adjoining county line.

For purposes of an address for safety and fire protection, the a gravel road which starts close to the SW corner of Section 24, Gallatin Co. and continue slightly to the northwest to end at the farmstead approximately 1/4 mile to the north, has been re-addressed at Weather Rock Rd. though before 2005 it carried the name of Johnson Rd.

The owner of the sections of land lying on either side of the petitioned road #432 would like the road abandoned for purposes of better management priorities for the property. New fencing on the perimeter and cross fencing on the property is being installed now for better grazing management of cattle and the growing of crops. This road abandonment will substantially help in this management plan.



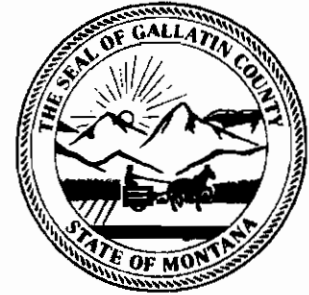

Dear Board,

According to 7-14-2603 M.C.A., the Board of County Commissioners shall cause an investigation to be made of the feasibility, desirability, and cost of granting the prayer of the petition. The investigation shall be sufficient to properly determine the merits or demerits of the petition.

The road, which petition was granted by the Board of County Commission on May 7, 1917, was viewed by the undersigned on June 9, 2006. The description of the road in Road Petition #432 is as follows: beginning at the southeast corner of Section 24, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, thence north along the section line one mile to intersect the present County Road.

We were able to locate an aluminum cap set by Daniel J. Boers (#14732LS), which helped us determine that the constructed road known as Weather Rock Road is not the same as Road Petition #432. This cap is located along the southeast corner of Section 24. In looking at Certificate of Survey No. 2127A, one can determine that Weather Rock Road is more best described as a private driveway, and located completely within Section 24, and also completely within Gallatin County.

The road as described in Road Petition #432 has not been constructed. We started at the southeast corner of Section 24, T3N, R7E., on Weather Rock Road, and headed north until Weather Rock Road ended. From there we traveled to the east boundary of the property and continued north for approximately 2/3 of a mile to the north end of Section

24. Here we were able to determine that the county road referred to in Road Petition #432 that "intersects with the present county road" was not constructed either.

Gallatin County has received documentation from Park County indicating that no records have been found in Park County that established any roads on the west section line of Section 19, T3N, R8E. In addition, we have a statement from Park County Planner Jackie Robbins, that Park County does not recognize this road as a county road.


