**Petition to discontinue a portion of West Main Street
within the Plat of the Town of Three Forks (Old Town)**

In accordance with Gallatin County Road Abandonment Procedures (*Procedure for the Abandonment of a County Road or Discontinuance of a Street or Alley in an Unincorporated Town, Gallatin County, Montana*) adopted March 17, 1992, by the Board of Gallatin County Commissioners, we hereby petition to abandon all that part of West Main Street lying west of the easterly right-of-way line of the former Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Co. according to the Plat of the Town of Three Forks (Old Town).

According to the above referenced document Section 3C, a petition for abandonment shall contain the following information:

1. *The particular road or roads to be abandoned, including a map showing the road.*

The road petitioned for discontinuance, vacation or abandonment is described as follows: All that part of West Main Street lying west of the easterly right-of-way line of the former Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Co. Refer to the enclosed drawing.

2. *The general route of the road.*

No road or traveled way has ever been constructed in this portion of the West Main St right-of-way.

3. *A description of the lands immediately adjacent to the road.*

The easternmost portion of the petition is bounded by the former Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Co. grade and borrow ditches on the northerly and southerly sides while the east side is bounded by West Main Street and that 40' wide portion of West Main Street abandoned per Gallatin County Resolution No. 1993-44, as filed with the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder on Film 138, Page 240. The western portion of the petition travels through unimproved pasture land.

4. *The names of the owners of the lands immediately adjacent to the road.*

Immediately adjacent land owners are as follows: Tract 1, Michael S. Huempfer; Tract 2, Don F. Scofield and Patsy D. Scofield Revocable Living Trust.

5. *A statement as to whether the owners of the land immediately adjacent to the road consent to the abandonment.*

Refer to the enclosed property owners list, petition and the signatures of adjoining landowners.

6. *If an owner of the land immediately adjacent to the road cannot be found, a statement of the efforts made to locate the owner. N/A*
7. All adjacent landowners within the unincorporated townsite have been found and consent to the abandonment.
8. *Information about other landowners, including the location of the land and identity of the owners, who could be affected by the abandonment.*

No traveled way was constructed within the original platted right-of-way. No other land owners of platted townsite lots will be affected by the abandonment. The former railroad property has legal and physical access to County Road No. 324 (Old Town Road) where the county road crosses the former railroad alignment approximately 670 feet northeast of West Main Street

9. *The necessity for and advantage of the abandonment of the road.*

Michael S. Huempfer owns the former railroad right-of-way that has crossed the petitioned road since construction of the railroad grade in 1907. Huempfer wishes to gain unity of title of the land within the former Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Co. right-of-way.

West Main Street, as originally platted, dead ends into a "small bayou" presumably to take advantage of river navigation. Since this portion of West Main Street was never constructed, no evidence of any past use of the right-of-way for river navigation exists, nor is it possible today due to river mechanics.

The lands owned by the Don F. Scofield and Patsy D. Scofield Revocable Living Trust (Scofield) are bisected by the petitioned right-of-way and are currently accessed by County Road No. 324, Old Town Road. The petition would also provide unity of title to the Scofield property to the west of the former railroad.

10. *The name and mailing address of the petitioners and a description of the property owned by the petitioners in the road district.*

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-104

A RESOLUTION TO ABANDON A PORTION OF WEST MAIN STREET IN THE OLD TOWN OF THREE FORKS ACCORDING TO ROAD PETITION NUMBER 831.

This Resolution was introduced by CLERK & RECORDER CHARLOTTE MILLS; moved by Commissioner SKINNER and seconded by Commissioner MURDOCK. The Resolution was adopted UNANIMOUSLY.

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2009, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder received a Petition, signed by adjacent landowners in Gallatin County, to abandon a portion of West Main Street located in the Old Town of Three Forks, pursuant to Title 7, Chapter-14, Part 26, Montana Code Annotated; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-14-2601(2)(b), MCA, defines the term "abandonment" to mean the cessation of use of a right-of-way (easement) or activity thereon with no intention to reclaim or use again; and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2009, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder certified that the Petition contained sufficient signatures as required by Section 7-14-2616(1) and the Petition was assigned County Road petition Number 831, MCA; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2009, the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder presented the Petition to Abandon the portion West Main Street in the Old Town of Three Forks to the Commission and the Commission appointed a viewing committee consisting of one County Commissioner and the County Surveyor, as required by Section 7-14-2603(1), MCA; and

WHEREAS, all the landowners immediately adjacent to the portion of the road to be abandoned have consented to its abandonment; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-14-2603, MCA, authorizes the Gallatin County Board of County Commissioners ("Commission") after considering the Petition and the results of an investigation, to make an entry on the minutes regarding its decision of whether to grant a Petition to abandon a county road; and

WHEREAS, the road is described as that portion of West Main Street adjacent to Blocks 26, and 27 then extending west to what is shown as the Small Bayou on the plat of the Town of Three Forks (Old Town), Gallatin County, Montana; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2009, the viewing committee reported to the Commission that they met to view the street being petitioned to be discontinued on Wednesday July 22, 2009. They drove to Old Town Three Forks to view West Main Street. The street ends at a fence next to the old railroad bed, and there is no indication that a street was constructed from the

railroad bed to the river. The owners of property accessed by this easement have signed the petition, and it was determined that they are accessing their property through other means.
; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2009, the viewing committee reported no one would become landlocked nor denied access to public lands if the Petition were granted and that the viewing committee believes it is feasible and desirable to grant the Petition; and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Bozeman Daily Chronicle on August 16 and 23, 2009; and

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2009, the Commission conducted a public hearing, after notice, on the Petition and the results of the viewing committee's investigation; and

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2009, the Commission found that granting the Petition and abandoning the portion West Main Street in the Old Town of Three Forks would serve the best interests of Gallatin County; and

WHEREAS, the Commission determined the portion of West Main Street in the Old Town of Three Forks would no longer be used for public purposes, abandonment will not create a public safety hazard, and no person would be denied access or become landlocked, and that abandonment of that portion of right-of-way is feasible; and

WHEREAS, the Commission voted unanimously to grant the Petition and abandon that portion of West Main Street adjacent to Blocks 26, and 27 then extending west to what is shown as the Small Bayou on the plat of the Town of Three Forks (Old Town), Gallatin County, Montana.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That portion of West Main Street adjacent to Blocks 26, and 27 then extending west to what is shown as the Small Bayou on the plat of the Town of Three Forks (Old Town), Gallatin County, Montana, as requested in the Petition, is hereby abandoned.
2. All right, title, and interest to the one hundred (100) foot West Main Street Right-of-Way lying west of the former Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railway Right-of-Way shall vest in the appropriate owners in accordance with Montana law;
3. All right, title, and interest to the one hundred (100) foot West Main Street Right-of-Way lying within the bounds of the former Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railway Right-of-Way shall vest in the appropriate owners in accordance with Montana law;
4. The Commission hereby requests the Clerk and Recorder, within ten (10) days from the date of passage of this Resolution of Abandonment, to send a copy of this

Resolution by certified mail to all owners of land abutting on the abandoned street. The owners shall be those listed on the last county assessment roll.

6. The Clerk and Recorder shall notify the county road supervisor by furnishing a certified copy of this Resolution to the supervisor.

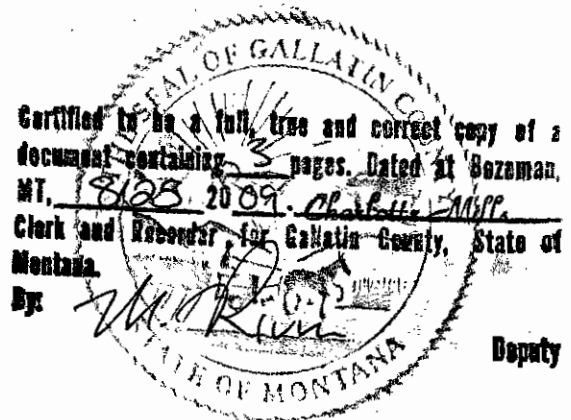

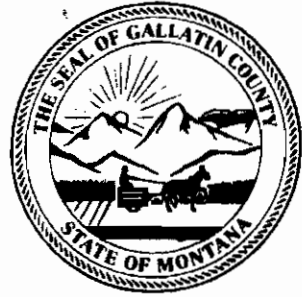
