

## WYTANA ROAD ABANDONMENT MAP



#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, Nicholas & Susan Schutter and Travis & Kari Ballenger (collectively, the "Grantors"), the owners of the legal and equitable title to the following described real estate, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, cash in hand, paid by GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA ("Grantee") and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, do hereby bargain, sell, grant, release, and convey unto the said Grantee an easement through, over, under, and across the following described real property, situated in Gallatin County, Montana, for a forty-foot public road right-of-way for the purpose of travel of the public, to wit:

All that part of the northwest quarter of Section 19, Township 1 North, Range Three East described as a forty-foot wide strip of land being twenty feet on each side of the following described centerline:
