I organize a Ringling/Maudlow ride each Fall that typically goes over the Bremmer Creek Road and ends at the bottom at the Dry Creek road. Usually up to 50 riders have participated. I have often cycled the Bremmer Creek Road myself and connected to the Rocky Mountain Road and on to Bozeman, a route not possible without Bremmer Creek Road. Bremmer Creek Road goes through a beautiful part of the Valley and it would be tragic to lose public access.

I'm writing to encourage you (1) to deny the petition to abandon the subject 3.4 -mile stretch of Bremer Creek Road and (2) if you do implement a seasonal closure, make it as narrow as possible to achieve the goal of preventing mud bogging.

I believe that this stretch of road is very valuable to people in the area who ride bikes. I'm aware of an annual Gallatin Valley Bike Club event that includes this stretch of road as well as an informal "race" that includes it (www.morganzo55.com). I'm also aware of people riding bikes out there independent of any event. Bikes designed for gravel/dirt roads have become very popular.

As for the scope of a seasonal closure, it would seem that springtime thaw is the critical period. It would also seem that on-road vehicles are the primary problem. Perhaps the road could remain open to people riding bikes, people on horses, and snowmobiles when it is snow-covered. Fat-tire bikes have become popular for over-snow riding. Further, non-motorized use is significantly more difficult in mud or slush, and so non-motorized users will likely self-select not to use during these conditions (and so need not be seasonally restricted).

As noted by the Viewing Committee, Bremer Road has been important to the residents of Gallatin County for more than 100 years, and it is very important to the cycling community as one of a handful of roads allowing us get a healthy workout with minimal vehicular traffic. Specifically, Bremmer Road allows us to connect Dry Creek Road to Rocky Mountain Road, making for a quiet scenic loop.

Forswall Road is an example of a road that is closed to "non-emergency vehicles" due to it being impassable when wet. However, if a bicycle is a "vehicle", then strictly speaking it is closed to bicycles also. It would be far preferable for the wording to be "closed to non-emergency motorized vehicles". This would allow for non-motorized access.

A bicycle or other human-powered vehicle is simply incapable of passing through when the road surface is muddy and so any risk of significant damage to the road is mitigated. However, there are times in the spring and autumn when roads are unsuitable for motorized vehicles but quite suitable for bicycles, hand cycles, and related forms of human-powered recreation.
Hyalite Canyon is an example of a road where, for many years, during spring breakup the road is closed to motorized travel to preserve the road surface, but open to non-motorized travel.

There are a number of other "impassable when wet" roads in the county which are prized by cyclists as a way to recreate away from vehicle traffic. For example, River Rd south of Norris Rd and Johnson Rd east of Gooch Hill Rd. Losing Bremer Rd would set a terrible precedent.

I'm writing to encourage you to deny the petition to abandon Bremer Creek Road as proposed by landowners adjacent to the road.

I'm a member of the sizable long-distance running community in Gallatin County. I frequently utilize Bremer Creek road for long runs. During colder months, I run in this area approximately once per month, often running with other long distance running enthusiasts in Bozeman. As a low-traffic road, it provides a safer and more pleasant alternative to Dry Creek and Rocky Mountain roads, which frequently have large truck traffic servicing area ranches and farms.

Bremer Creek Road is especially valuable to runners like me during shoulder seasons when the ground is frozen, snowpack is light in lower elevations, but higher elevation snowpack makes Bridger Mountain trails or high-altitude roads like Flathead Pass impassable. I support closure of this road to non-emergency vehicles during snow and break-up seasons, but only if it remains open to pedestrian use. Closure to pedestrians during cold shoulder seasons would harm the greatest benefit this road has for the running community that uses it.

As a side note: I'd encourage the commission to make materials relevant to decisions, such as the public petition to abandon this road and the investigation of feasibility, available online before the deadline for public comments. It's only
through dogged efforts of concerned users of this road with connections to the commission that I was able to learn about the details of this proposal.

An additional closure should be studied, one during rifle season, as all the land along Bremmer Creek is private. Poaching and trespass issues are a serious infraction. Hunters and others may use the road simply to connect through, and that is why this matter needs more study.

However I wish to make a significant modification to any recommended closure. Bremmer Creek Road is a prominent bicycle route. The closure should be for motor vehicles only. Bicycles may be appropriate at times during closure periods. Fatbikes might be able to navigate Bremmer Creek Road during extremely cold or icy conditions. Bicycles cannot cause the damage issues attributed to motor vehicles, due to the nature of bicycle's light weight and human power, or electrically assisted fractional horsepower on some models.

Those in the north part of the country, eg Nixon road and Bremer Road, are both rich and miserable out of season. Similar roads include the 'Summer Cutoff Road (old-days)' near the Comona Crossing north of Riverside Country Club and 'isn't it named the Anceny Road' northwest of Four Corners.

I encourage you to maintain such public roads and to close them to motorized travel in muddy-snowy seasons when use is abuse, ie whenever even the shallowest of tracks are being left. I see no harm in leaving them open year-around to walking, skiing, and even biking during seasons of closure.

The USFS manages some of its 'back-country' roads similarly, sometimes enforcing rest with locked barriers.

Gentlemen, I would briefly like to state that my wife and I support one or more seasonal closures* to non-emergency, motorized vehicle use on Bremer Creek Road when environmental conditions place the road surface at moderate-high risk of degradation from vehicle use. In select emergencies, it might also be acceptable for local landowners to use portions of this road during closure periods to protect/manage time-sensitive issues on their property (hopefully they would be as careful as possible when using the road during closure periods to keep impacts to the road surface to a minimum).
Seasonal road closures are not new in Montana, as such closures are common on access roads to public lands and weight limits during spring thaw on select paved roadways. During closures the public should be able to continue to use the road for recreational uses, such a hiking and biking. Hopefully such an approach will lessen costs to the County road maintenance program and continue to allow for public access to this rural and beautiful part of the county. I am not one of the landowners who petitioned for the closure of Bremer Creek Road. My family does ranch north of Bremer Creek Road.

The problems, as I understand it, are with people who drive this road to trespass and poach on private land, the people who go out on this road to party and leave beer cans and other litter behind, and the people who ignore the "impassable when wet" signs and create huge ruts in the road. The people who want to walk on the road for birding or exercise, or the mountain bikers and horse owners who want a backroad experience, are not causing the problems forcing landowners to request closure of this road. I am wondering if a compromise solution would be to have a very narrow gate for the mountain biker, birder, walkers, and horseback riders, to access the road on each end next to a locked gate for the landowners. There is no state land on Bremer Creek Road so this would not deny the public access to state land. There is an alternate route in Dry Creek Road so this would not restrict travel to Maudlow and Ringling.

There is precedent for this solution. Hyalite Road is closed to vehicles and open to non-vehicle traffic only each spring when the road is extremely wet which is often the case with Bremer Creek Road. The ruts created by "mud-boggers" and others who attempt Bremer Creek Road when it is wet, create long-term problems with drainage and safe passage for those who need to drive the road to access their land and cattle.

I hope you will consider this comment when making a final decision on the petition to close Bremer Creek Road. I am uncertain about attending the public hearing due to coronavirus concerns.

Please do not enclose this important passageway. I do not blame Wade Morgan and others for being frustrated that motorized users make a mess of this road when it is wet---closure to motorized users would not break my heart, because some people do abuse their right to drive on that road by doing so when conditions are lousy. (Bear Creek road suffers similarly).
But it seems extremely unfair, counterproductive, and bad PR for the agricultural/landowner community to simply close off a public road completely.
This feels very personal to me....as a small-scale rancher at the north end of Springhill Road involved with a diverse operation and no employees, I cherish the rare moments I get to travel off the beaten path, and that road is a place I often explore on foot, XC-skis or sometimes a bike. I'm usually there when no on else is around. My husband is no longer able to get around the way he used to, so my forays are generally limited to short trips so I can't take care of things at home, and I savor even a mundane dirt road if it gets me out of the Bozeman orbit. Yeah, i'd like deeper expeditions into the wilderness, and I do use public lands to get up into the hills when ! can, but those opportunities are absurdly rare. The road to Maudiow offers a unique window into the ag/homesteading/geographic transition at this northerly edge of the Gallatin Valley---it serves everyone well, including large landowners, to share this one small passageway in a vast, inaccessible private acreage of the West Bridgers.
