

Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED; Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road - 40 - feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at the Northwest corner of the North east quarter (NE 1/4) sec. 8, T. 2. N. R. 7. E. thence due south on quarter section line, one mile thence southerly, around a hill and northeasterly again to connect with County Road.

(b) All of sec. 8 and North half sec. 17, T. 2. N. R. 7. E.

(c) W. Morgan owns NW 1/4 sec. 8, T. 2. N. R. 7. E.

(d) All consent

(e) All agree to move and do fencing at their own expense, except Morgan and Davidson who ask the county to furnish wire and remove fences and do their fencing

(f) The cost would not exceed \$100-

(g.) The proposed road is a public necessity because it is the only road over which we can haul a load winter or summer without going thru our neighbors fields, and these fields can no longer be used for road purposes.
